

## Ecosystems Brochure

### 30 points

Individually, you are going to create a brochure about a new ecosystem. Using the vocabulary you learned this week about ecosystems, you are going to explain what can be found there. It will be graded on the following criteria:

#### Vocabulary (10 points)

- Define at least 10 vocabulary words from your notes about ecosystems throughout your brochure
- They should be accurate and well organized

#### Examples (10 points)

- Your brochure should include drawings of examples
- At least 5 of your vocabulary definitions need a visual example
  - For example, if you defined producer, you could draw a green plant
- Make sure your visual examples are labeled and/or are near the written definition

#### Color, Creativity, and Attractiveness (10 points)

- Brochures are meant to be informative while grabbing someone's attention
- Organize your brochure in a logical and user-friendly way
- All 6 flaps are filled
- Neatly add color to your brochure
- Add unique touches such as a name for your ecosystem and different species in it
  - You can even include slogans or places to receive more information in your brochure
  - You could create a map of your ecosystem or include coupons
  - Add extra fun facts and games to quiz others on the information
