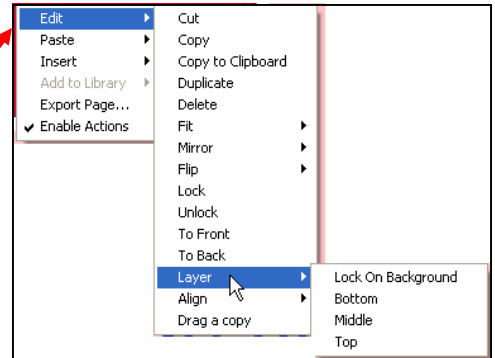




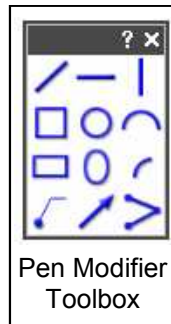
MAGIC REVEALER

Magic Revealers are a great way to add hidden content to a flipchart, that can be revealed later in a lesson.

1. Place an object on the flipchart page to see through. You have access to many shapes and images in the Resource Library.
2. Type or add an object to be seen. (Remember this is what will be hidden behind and will be revealed using the Magic Revealer.)
3. Object to see through needs to be on top layer. Do this by right-clicking on the object, select “Edit - Layer - Top.”



4. Create your revealer by right-clicking on the “Pen Tool” to open the “Pen Modifier Toolbox.” Select an annotation type, and use the Activpen to draw. Right-clicking on the toolbox a second time will make the “Pen Modifier Toolbox” disappear.



5. Duplicate your revealer. Do this by using the “Marquee Select Tool,” right-click on the shape and select, “Edit - Duplicate.”



6. Use the “Fill Tool” to fill in the duplicate of the revealer you just made.



7. Erase the fill as close to the edge as possible.



8. Put the second revealer to the front. Do this by right-clicking on the shape and select, “Edit - To Front.”

9. Draw a wand stick by right-clicking on the “Pen Tool” to get to the “Pen Modifier Toolbox.”

10. Group together by using the “Marquee Select Tool” and drag a box around both of the objects.



11. Once you click off the screen or board, click on the “Group icon” to group the objects together.
