

Saving Pictures from United Streaming

1. Open Internet Explorer to go to the Internet.
2. Type in the address bar: www.unitedstreaming.com and click **enter**.



3. Login to Unitedstreaming.

4. Search for an image in the search box at the top of the page.

3. Click "GO".


5. Preview your results. Select a picture you like.


Click the elephant to see the sizes of the pictures that you can save.

6. Download the picture by clicking the blue icon.




Left - click on the blue icon next to the "large" label. This is the download button.

7. Click Save.

9. To find your picture, double click "My Documents" icon on your desktop. Then click "My pictures" and look for the name of your picture.

Saving Pictures from the Internet

Let's say you can't find the picture you want in UnitedStreaming. You can also look on the Internet. For example, <http://pics4learning.com> also has many pictures for you to download without violating copyright laws. Follow the same direction as above:

1. Type in <http://pics4learning.com> and click enter within Internet Explorer.
2. In the search box on the left-hand side, type in your keyword (example: *elephant*) and click "go".
3. Click on the little picture that you want to select it.
4. Click the "download image" button. (see below)
