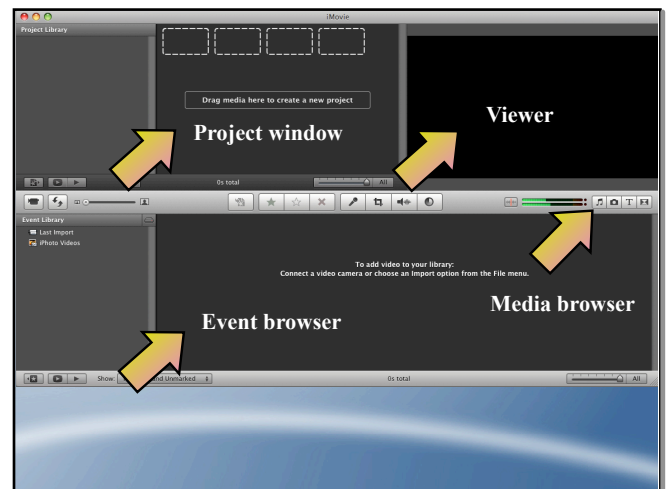

Objectives

- Explore iMovie program tools: event browser, viewer, project window, media browser.
- Record digital video using the built-in iSight camera.
- Create an iMovie project with title, transitions, and sound.

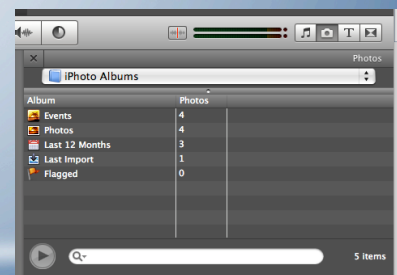


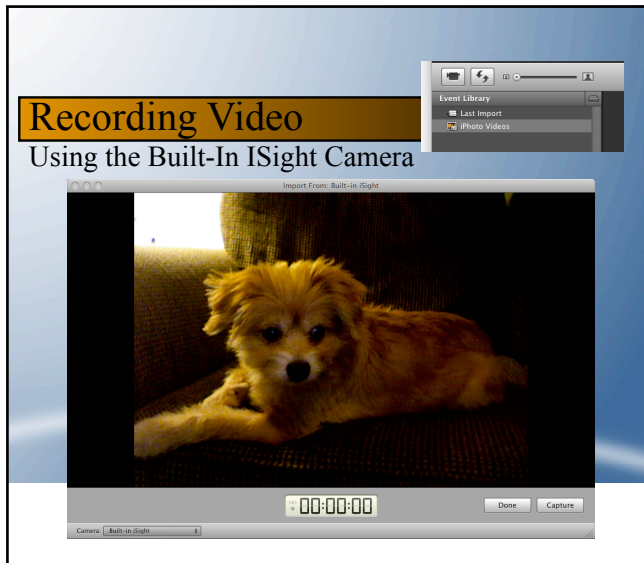
Creating a Project

1. Connect camera to Mac and import video.
2. Name the event.
3. Click the name for the event and view the thumbnails.
4. Skim video in the event browser and click to select a section. Drag and drop it in the Project window. Add and arrange clips.
5. Add music, photos, titles, and transitions.
6. Add a theme (if available) and adjust default titles.
7. Use the Play Full Screen button to view your movie!

- Launch the iMovie program and start a new project.
- Use the built-in iSight camera to record at least two video clips. They will appear in your event browser.
- Select clips from your video and move them to the project window.
- Add a title, transitions, and music.
- Play and enjoy your movie!
