

Final tasks of choice for the film „Juno“

1. With Glogster, create a poster on the topic teenage pregnancy in the US.

Possibility 1: Draw a **comparison** to either GB, Germany or Europe in general if possible.

Possibility 2: Teenage pregnancy in different **ethnic groups** in the US.

Include information AND statistics using at least one of the following web pages as a source:

Present your poster and your findings in an appropriate way to the class in the end (10-15 minutes). You might add some more information then.

2. In a group of 3 (not more, not less) people, prepare a role play on one of the discussed topics from the film (problems, parents, friends, solution, school) in the context of teenage pregnancy.

Each of the group members should talk at least 5 minutes.

One of the group members must be a pregnant girl, the other two might either be the father of the child, the girl's parents, one friend/schoolmate or a school counsellor¹.

3. Write an alternative ending for the film JUNO.

Choose between one of the following types of texts:
blog entry, report, diary entry.

Your text should answer the following questions:

- What happens to the baby?
- How does the relationship of the teenage couple develop?
- How do their parents react?
- How do friends react?
- What changes and challenges wait for the teenage parents in the future?

Your text should contain at least 400 words.
