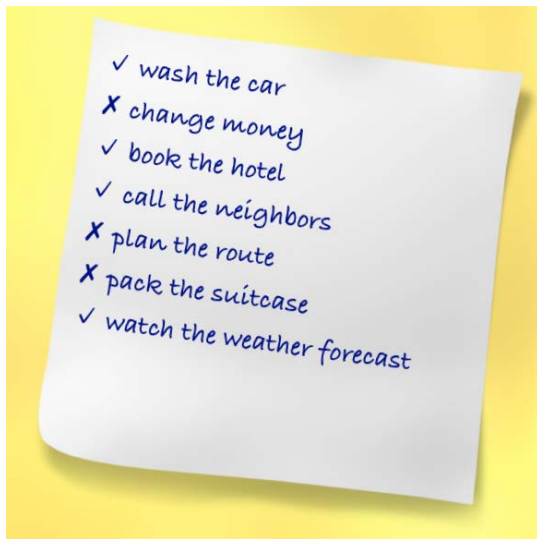


## Handout 1
