

Components of A+ Enriched Assessment



Arts Integration

Students are given many options in demonstrating knowledge and understanding that include dance, drama, music, and visual arts.



Multiple Intelligences

Assessment is grounded in the concept that children are smart in different ways.



Short Feedback Loop

Learners are coached throughout the learning process as it happens so both learner and facilitator/teacher know how learning and understanding are happening. Learners do not have to wait long intervals for an assessment of their performance.



Collaboration

The effort involves teachers, students, parents and community to understand expectations.



Multiple Evaluations

Teachers use combinations of many different tools and observations to evaluate a student's performance.



Unexpected Outcomes

Unplanned results often occur that were not anticipated by the teacher.



Clear Criteria

Clarity of criteria is established so that students, parents, schools and communities understand clearly what is expected, how their performance will be evaluated and how to interpret grades.
