 - a) How have actions by developed countries in their own self-interest severely hurt developing countries? Please give an example.
 - b) How has aid from developed countries not helped or actually increased problems? Please give an example.
 - c) How have forces internal to a poor country caused poverty in that country? Please give an example.
3. Please give me some advice about Guatemala. What changes would you propose? Why?
4. How did your project change your perspective on development? Ideally give two examples.
5. How did this class change your view of OUR (USA) development and actions that you take in your life?
6. "The best development action is education" – *an unbiased university professor*. Provide your response with support from our readings and discussions. I don't care if you agree with the statement. You only have to support your answer.
7. Give an example of an intervention that you find to be successful in helping people. State why it was successful.
