

Confucianism

- (lǐ, 禮) sense of manners behave in appropriate way.
- (rén, 仁) humaneness Golden Rule: "What you do not wish for yourself, do not do to others
- (xiào 孝) *filial devotion* is considered among the greatest of virtues and must be shown towards both the living and the dead family.
- (Jun zi) 君子 superior individuals proper man.
- Came from BOOK OF SONGS; BOOK OF HISTORY; AND BOOK OF RITES Zhou Dynasty (rise of dao and Confucian)
- xiào 孝 is the social order of China.
- Written book is called Analects recorded by pupils.
- Confucian educational tests were the center of entering the bureaucratic merit.

HINDUISM

- *Dharma* (ethics and duties)
- *Artha* (enjoyment of social physical and sexual pleasure.)
- *Samsara* (The continuing cycle of birth, life, death and rebirth)
- *Karma* (action and subsequent reaction)
- *Moksha* (liberation from the cycle of *samsara*)
- Brahmins highly held in social structure as they are the workers of the religion.
- Came from VEDAS; UPANISHADS , Mahabharata and Ramayana
- Kshatriya warrior, shudras serve, vaishayas work, and Brahmins learn scriptures/seek wisdom.
- I **THINK** they wrote *Bhagavad Gita* (Song of the Lord)
- Brahmins supported educational system that promoted Hindu values.
