

# How To: WallWisher

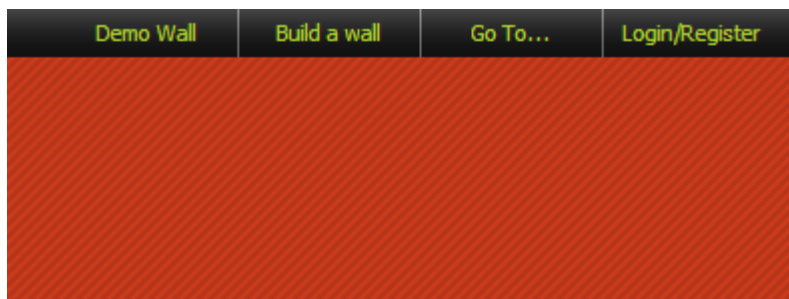

**Step 1:** In the address bar, type in <http://www.wallwisher.com>




**Step 2:** In the right -hand corner of the page, there is a section of four tabs



The first thing you want to do is select Login/Register.

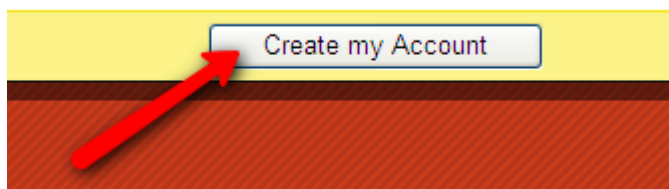


**Step 3:** After you click that, it will bring you to a new screen.

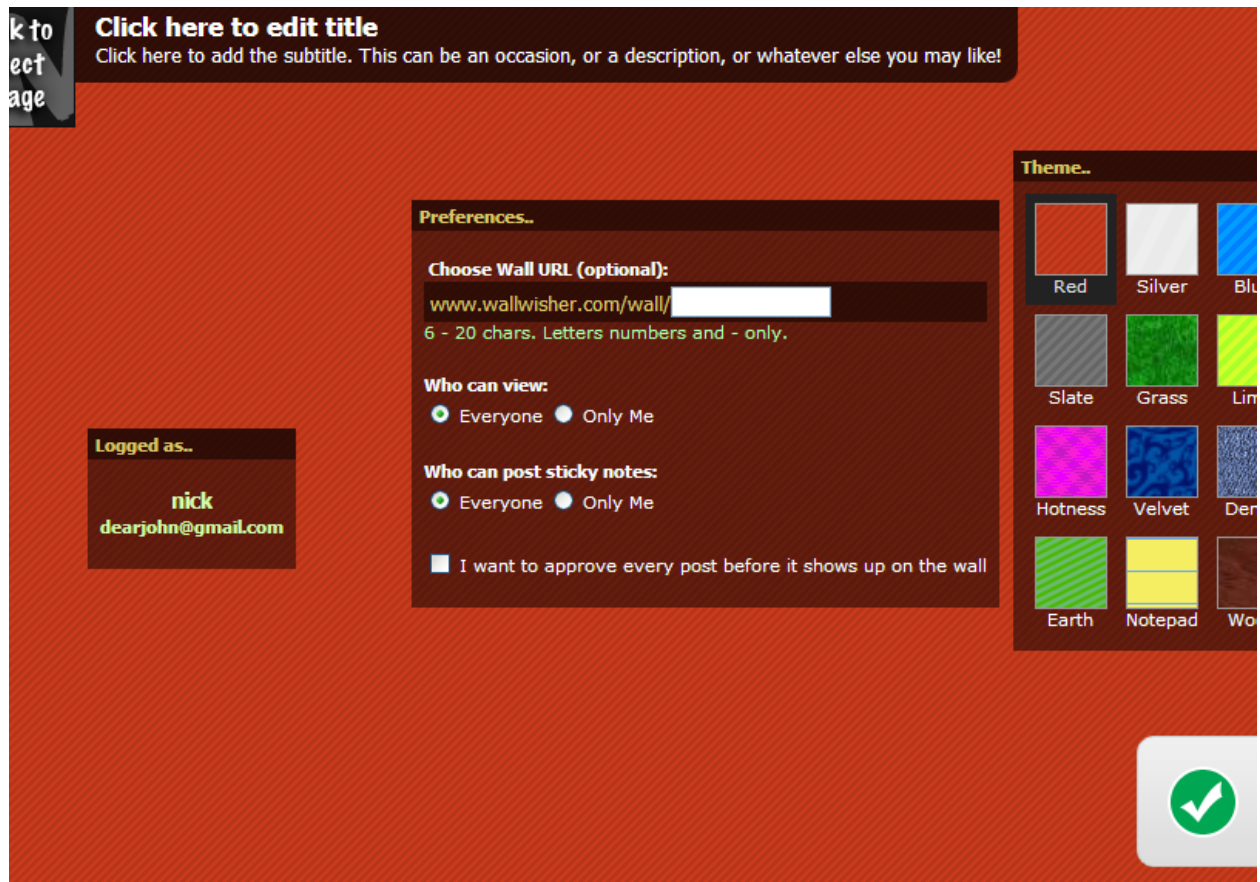

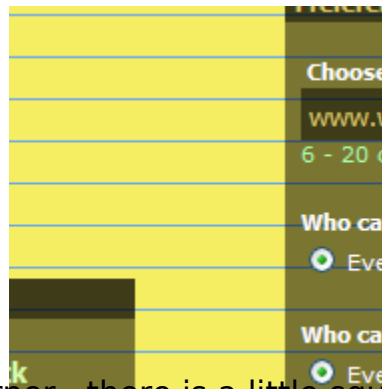

**Step 7:** You can change the theme of your wall to any one of these choices.

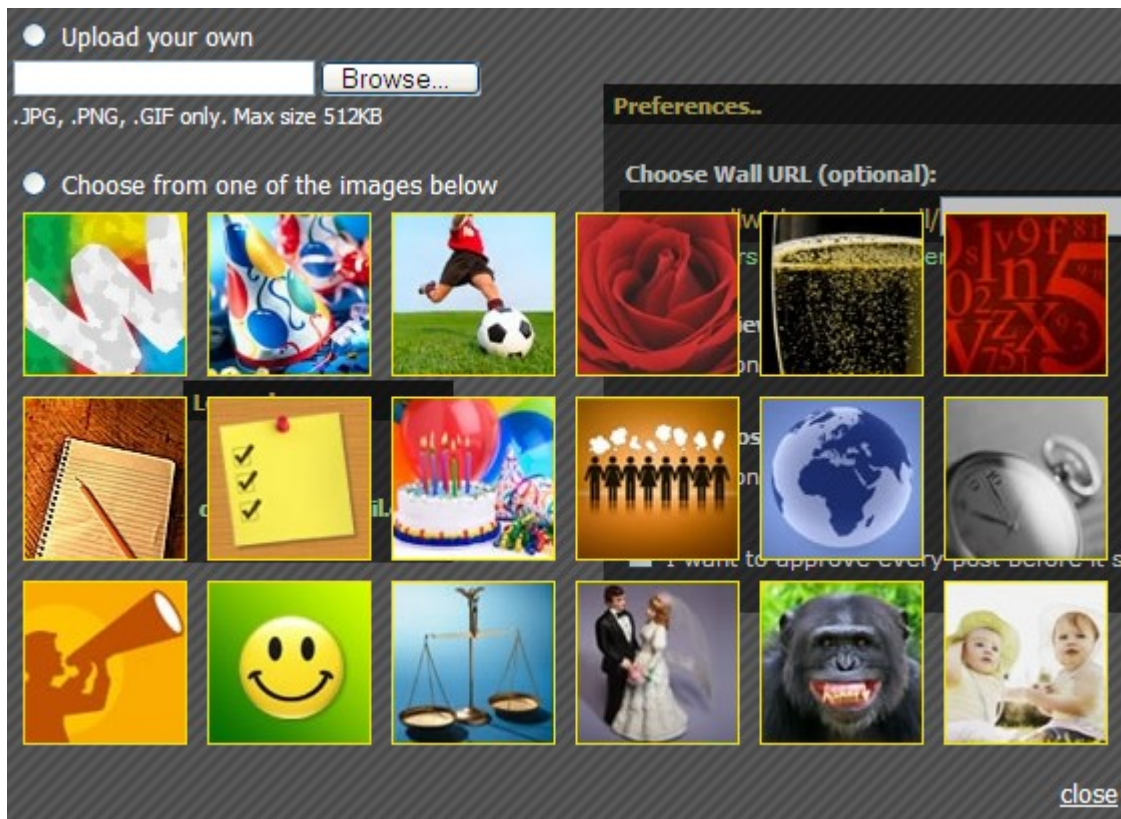


**Step 8:** In the top left-hand corner , there is a little square that says “Click to add Image”



Click.

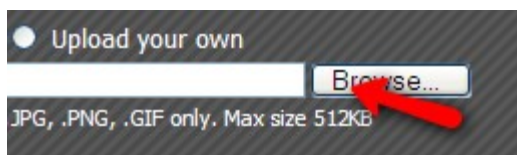
It will bring you to this screen,



From there, you will select the image you would like to use as your display.

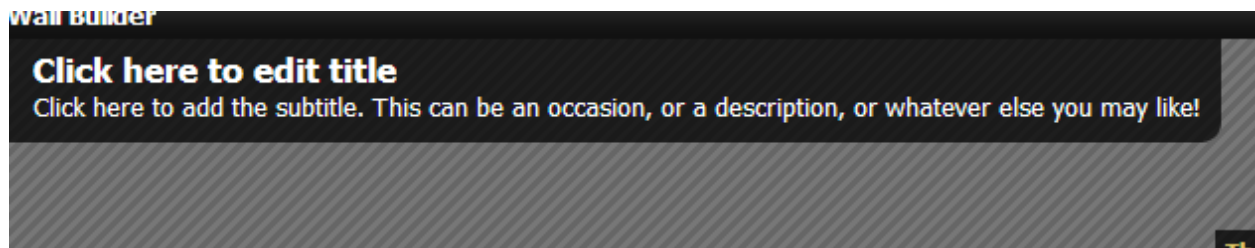
OR

You can upload your own from a saved file on your computer

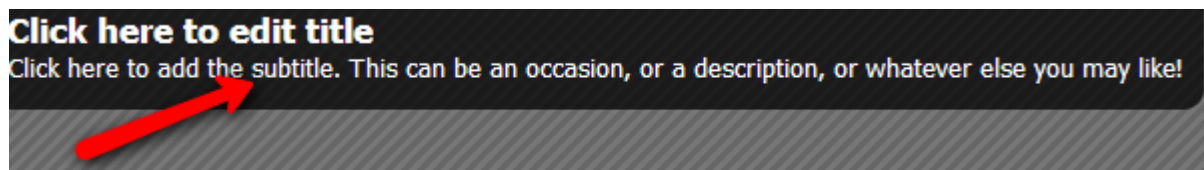


After you have selected your image, Click "close" at the bottom right-hand corner.

After creating a title, you will need to create a subtitle, which is right below the Title.
