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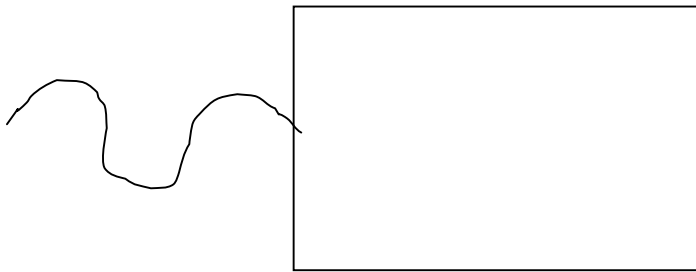
# Question Key

# Secret Code

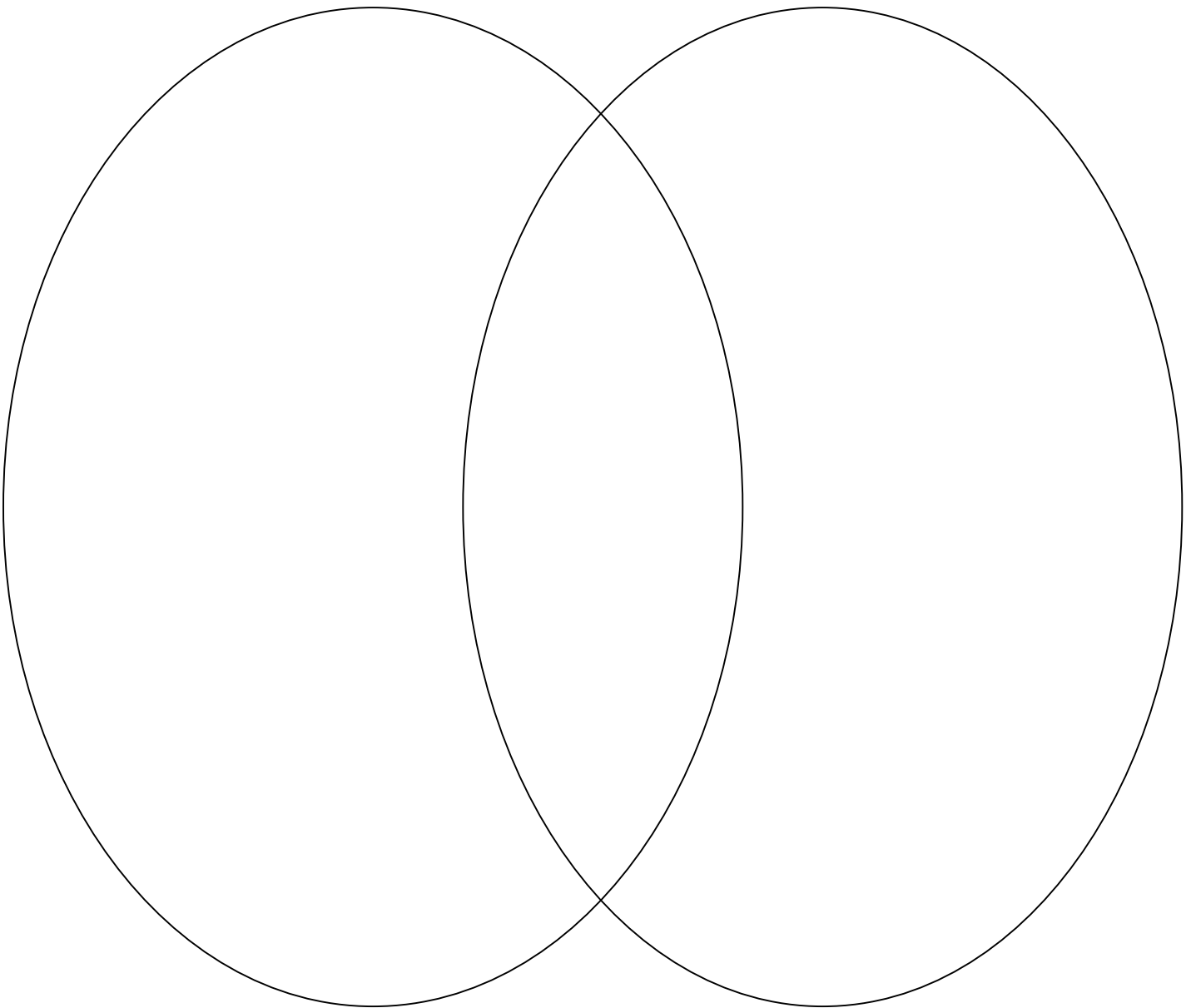
Make up a secret code. Write a secret Christmas message using the code. Give it to someone to solve.
