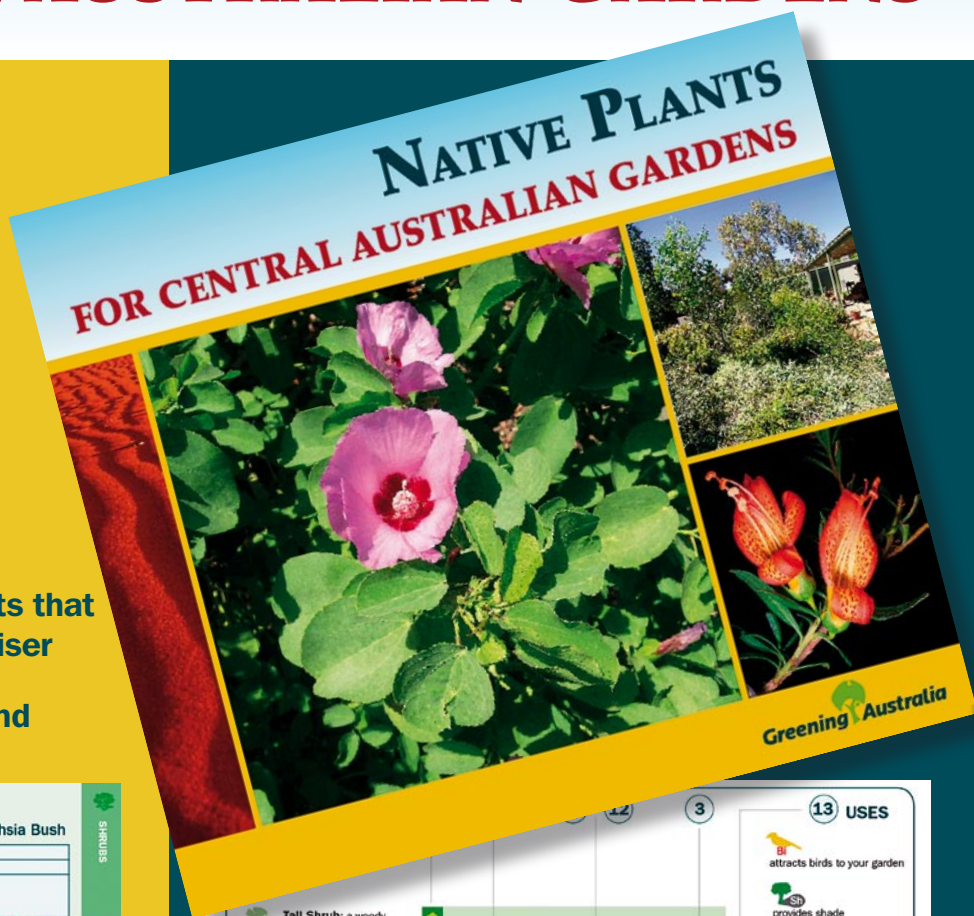

Family: MYOPORACEAE	Commonly found: Dolomite ridges, stony rises and rocky gullies
Growth speed: Medium	Lifespan: Medium
Salt tolerant: No	Flowers: May - October

**Dolomite Fuchsia Bush**

Height: 1 - 2 m
Frost sensitive: No
Uses:

In the garden: A shrub characterised by upright stems and small leaves and a prolific show of mauve flowers in winter and spring. A variety of forms are available which differ in flower colour (can be white, pink or mauve) and habit (can be compact or spreading). Flowers last well as cut flowers. Needs well drained soils. Tolerates frost, dry periods and growing in shady areas. Prune hard at the end of summer to prevent plant becoming woody. Propagate from cuttings.

**Acacia aneura**

Family: Mimosaceae	Commonly found: Wooded areas, riparian zones
Growth speed: Medium	Lifespan: Long
Salt tolerant: No	Flowers: Year-round

**Tall Shrub:** a woody multi-stemmed plant less than 6 m tall

**Shrub:** a woody multi-stemmed plant less than 2 m tall

**Groundcover:** a non-woody plant usually less than 1 m tall

**Vine:** a plant with a weak stem that derives support from climbing or creeping

**Grass:** a non-woody plant with narrow strap like leaves, generally growing in tussocks

**USES**

- attracts birds to your garden
- provides shade
- useful for planting in courtyards or small gardens
- screening plant
- suited to rocky areas
- barrier plant with prickles
- will grow under shade
- grows well in clay soils
- salt tolerant
