Have you ever noticed how much you can learn from reading a cereal box? Lots of interesting things are there... you just have to read! This week you are going to help me and help your classmates to learn about new and interesting people! You are going to create cereal that educates! Good luck and have fun! You will devote each side of the cereal box to one section of the project. The directions for each section follow:

- Using the person you chose and follow these instructions:

Cereal Box Front:

- ❑ Picture of Famous Figure
- ❑ Quotes that the famous figure said
- ❑ Cereal's Name, make it a catchy name, e.g. Corn Popes the II
- ❑ Famous Figure's name
- ❑ Lots of color – make it fun! Be creative

1st side: Ingredients:

- ❑ 5 Adjectives that describe your person
- ❑ 5 fun facts of this person. Things nobody knows and you found it was interesting. E.g. In 1895, at the age of 17, Einstein, one of the greatest minds ever born actually failed his university entrance exam into the Swiss Federal Polytechnical School. Actually he passed the Science and the Math sections, but failed in the rest of it like History and Geography. When asked later about this, he said that they were too boring and he didn't feel like answering them correctly!

Research! Don't tell us things we know already of this person! The idea is for you to share fun and interesting facts of this person.

2nd side of the box: Time Line:

- ☐ At least 10 important events of this person's life:
 - Complete date (e.g. February 14, 1922)
- ☐ Event listing
- ☐ Time line Title
- ☐ Neat and Organized

Back of the Box:

- ☐ A short bio of your person. IN YOUR OWN WORDS! In 2 paragraphs, tell about their life, accomplishments, problems, family, marriages, jobs, etc...
- ☐ Print out summary from computer
- ☐ Colorful and organized

Bottom of the box: YOUR name

Share your box with the class: You will present to the class your person, their life, what you learned and why this person is important or significant.

Read cereal boxes in class: On the last day, when everybody is done presenting you read other people's boxes!

BONUS: Dress up as your Famous person on the day of your presentation and get 10 bonus points!
