



## ORGANIC ARMENIA

6 Days/5 Nights

*If you are tired of everyday problems, it is time to go on an eco-tour to Armenia. You will get energized by the beautiful nature, fresh and clean air, and palette of colors. You will discover a new world for you. By visiting Armenia you will taste organic fruits and vegetables, feel the ecological atmosphere surrounding our products and see how they are grown just from the first hand.*



**Day 1:** Transfer from the airport to a centrally located hotel. Overnight (15 Km).

**Day 2: Yerevan - Byurakan - Amberd fortress – Stepanavan (overnight) (70 Km)**

Breakfast at the hotel. Trip to Byurakan – observatory located on the slope of Mount Aragats in the village of Byurakan. Amberd fortress – "fortress in the clouds" is a 7th-century fortress located 2,300 meters (7,500 ft) above the sea level. Afterwards, you will continue your way to Stepanavan (overnight).

**Day 3: Stepanavan Dendropark - Parz lich – Dilijan – Goshavank (overnight) (80 Km)**

The Stepanavan Dendropark is located in Lori region (about 85 km north of Yerevan). It was established in 1933 by Polish engineer-forester Edmon Leonovich. The dendropark is 35 ha in total of which 17.5 ha consists of natural forest and 15 ha of ornamental trees. It is one of the most remarkable natural zones in Armenia. Mostly the plants were brought from Yerevan botanic garden, but there are also species from different countries all over the world. Another beautiful spot is the Lake Parz located in a thick forest, a bit north of Dilijan Town. In Dilijan you will also visit Goshavank – a monastery ensemble. Overnight at Best Western Paradise hotel.



**Day 4: Dilijan – Noravank – Khor Virap – plantation of melons (lunch) - Yerevan (overnight) (300 Km)**

Breakfast at the hotel. You will be led through the plains of the Ararat valley to the magnificent monastery of Khor Virap, set against the backdrop of towering Mount Ararat. The monastery is a place of pilgrimage and is the site of the prison where St. Gregory the Illuminator (who brought Christianity to Armenia in 301 AD) was imprisoned. Continue the way to Noravank. The monastery is best known for its two-storey S. Astvatsatsin church, which grants access to the second floor by way of narrow stones jutting out from the face of building. Near Khor Virap you will have a lunch in a beautiful place and will go to the plantation of melons. Return to Yerevan. Overnight at a centrally located hotel.

**Day 5: Yerevan – Garni – Geghard – Yerevan (overnight) (90 Km)**



Breakfast at the hotel. A trip to Geghard, another incredible ancient Armenian monastery, entirely carved out of a mountain, will be followed by a visit to the magnificent temple of the Sun in Garni. Return to Yerevan. Overnight at a centrally located hotel.

**Day 6: Departure day. Transfer to the airport (15 Km)**
