1. Use of provenance evidence to enhance our knowledge of the early use of books:

Which books were printed in Venice and exported, purchased, and used in Germany or Poland in the fifteenth century?

Or printed in Nuremberg and used in Italy in the 16c?
And used by whom?

How?

How much did early printed books cost?

Were there any female readers?

And what kind of books were purchased by students, lawyers, or priests, in the 15th, 16th or later centuries, in Italy, France or anywhere else?

Which mathematical editions were acquired by religious institutions?

Who was buying Ptolemy in the Renaissance? Who was collecting it in the 18c?

Where are today the books once owned by Angelo Poliziano, or the Benedictines of San Giorgio of Venice?

Can we quantify the amount of 15c printed books which entered European and American collections as a direct consequence of the dissolution of religious institutions and their libraries in the 18c and 19c?

3. Use of provenance evidence to track the dissemination of texts, that is their reception

Where were distributed, who purchased and annotated the copies of Ptolemy's *Cosmographia*?

4. Use of provenance evidence to identify ownership:

Coat of arms, inscriptions, ex libris, historical shelfmarks, bindings, etc.
