

## **Grendel Multi-Genre Piece**

A Multi-Genre uses narratives, poems, songs, interviews, photographs, and other genres to create a portrait of the subject. These works are NOT biographies or research papers. Any work that is simply biography or summary will not be accepted. Nor are they essays. You are not trying to explicitly articulate a position about your topic. You are, instead, using a variety of genres to create "moments" that, taken together, may lead to a reader to create his or her own interpretation of the subject.

Assignment: You will work in pairs and create a multi-genre work for Grendel. Each chapter must be addressed. So there will be 12 total pieces. But this is not all. You must also explain what you are attempting to do with each piece, what essence of chapter you are trying to capture.

You can't use more than 3 pieces in the same genre.

Grading: You and your partner will be graded on grammar and mechanics (obviously), effort, creativity/originality, and how well you explain each piece.
