### ADOBE CONNECT IN EDUCATION

Adobe Connect has over 50 new features and introduces new elements that allow users to experience richer online communication. These include: blended e-learning curriculum management for real-time and self-paced learning, as well as many quiz types.

Adobe Connect can be used to establish a virtual school community for curriculum development and professional learning. Educators have the capacity to teach, learn and collaborate with anyone, anywhere at any time.

### WHAT IS ADOBE CONNECT?

Adobe Acrobat Connect is a web-conferencing solution that allows communication and collaboration between up to 2,500 people. It is easy to use, rapidly creates and tracks meetings, and supports multimedia content.

### HOW DOES IT WORK?

Up to 15 people (including the host) can collaborate via the web in real time. In your meeting room, you and other guests can share your computer screens, use text chat, broadcast live video and review meeting notes.

### GETTING STARTED

You can start using Adobe Connect by requesting an account. To do so, login to the portal and click **Tools** on the menu. Launch **ABEL Tools** and click on the appropriate tab to select **Adobe Connect**. Click **Request Account** and submit the form.
