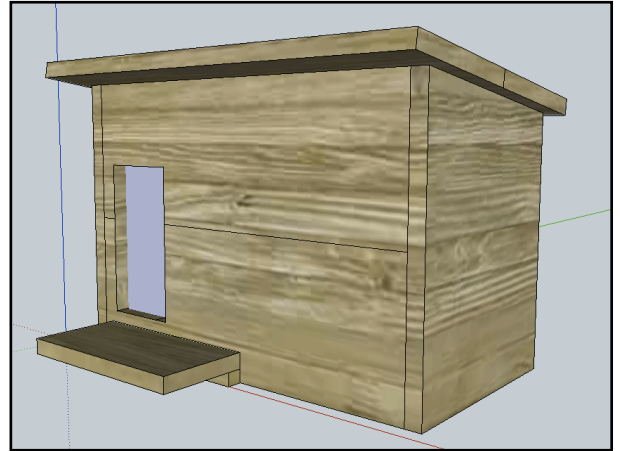


All About You Website
