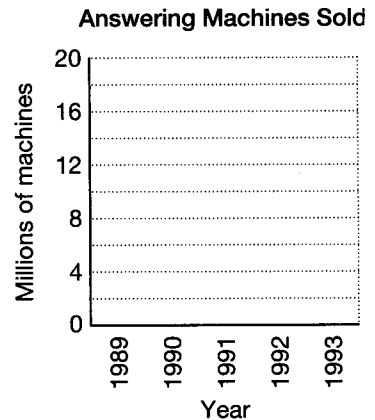


Scales and Bar Graphs

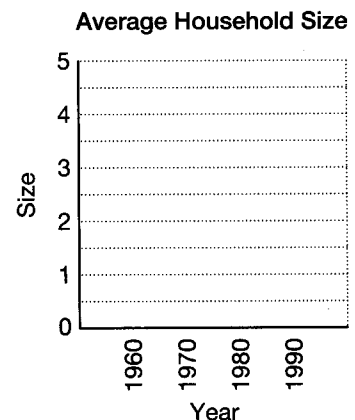
1. Make a bar graph from the data showing the number of answering machines sold from 1989 to 1993.
