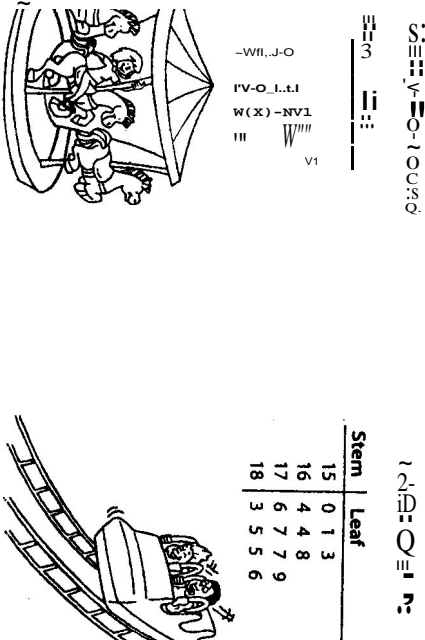
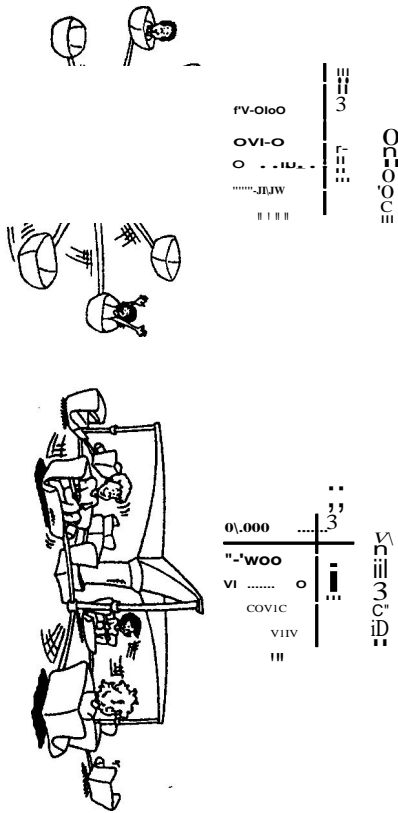


34 Stem-and-Leaf Diagrams: Hold on to Your Hats!
