Don't do a RED task if already done. Weeding will be a slow, steady process over time – do just a little each week.

(The rest of the current herbs are beyond harvesting)	<div>- Cut other herbs 3" from bottom and discard.</div> <div>- Fertilize bed with fish emulsion</div> <div>- Plant some basil and parsley ó GAIL</div> <div>- Weed</div> <div>- Reposition scarecrow ropes to avoid tripping hazard</div>	

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
