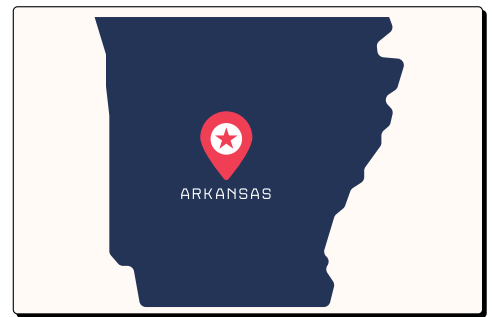

## Filing Deadline



- Major party candidate deadline
  - March 1, 2022
- Independent candidate deadline
  - May 2, 2022
- Declaration of intent for write-in candidacy (general)
  - August 10, 2022

## General Election Rules

### Uncontested Elections

- Uncontested elections are not canceled

### Write In

- Write-in candidates must file

### Replacement Candidates

- Replacement candidates allowed
  - Filing deadline August 24, 2022

### Winning

- Plurality (if primary was held) and majority (if no primary was held)
- Can advance to general runoff if no primary was held.

## Primary Election Rules



### Uncontested Elections

- Uncontested primaries are not cancelled

### Official Political Parties

- Recognized parties
  - Democratic, Libertarian and Republican

### Write In

- Write-in candidates do not need to file
- Write-in votes shall not be counted in primary elections

### Winning

- Majority required
- No outright win
- Yes primary runoffs

## Local Rules



- Applies to Little Rock (city) and Little Rock School District:
  - Primaries are not held, so general runoffs can happen. General runoffs are NOT called if (1) a candidate receives a majority of the vote OR (2) a candidate received 40%+ of the vote and the second-place winner is behind by at least 20% of the vote.
