Students with certain withdrawal codes are reported to the FL Dept of Motor Vehicles for license suspension. If a student drops out of school (DNE, W05, W15-W23) their record is reported every Friday to the FDMV. We recently adjusted our coding so that any student who withdraws to another school in the district and does not subsequently enroll after 20 days, or to Home School after 30 days, we change the WD code from W02 or W24 to W22 - Whereabouts Unknown. This makes sense as we don't know where the student went.

We know that many more students are being reported. When parents contact the school, we are able to correct the final WD code (if they went to private school, another public school outside of Florida, etc.). This puts the responsibility on the parent to let us know what school the student has entered outside of a district school. It's all about accountability!!!!

Attached are the two statutes that pertain to driver's licenses and students. s322.091 makes it clear a student must enrolled or some other approved program of study. For your reference, I've attached 1003.27 which really affects students under the age of 16 where compulsory attendance is still required (students are not required to attend school once they've reached the age of 16 so it's legal that the student in question has dropped out.

I know there's a routine standard form and regular (end of each nine weeks, I think) reporting process the district uses to get the info to the Motor Vehicles Dept who, in turn, notifies the student and parent of suspension of privileges. Until district offices reopen next Tuesday, I cannot get the staffer or the specifics to you.

I would appreciate your relaying this info to the parent and get for me--if the parent is willing--his/her name, the name of the student and school last attended, and the parent's day-time phone number and I'll have a district person who has better info than I get back to the parent on Tuesday or Wednesday at the latest (school's out until the 7th).
