 D. Follow directions as to the number of candidates to be marked for each office.
 E. To vote for a person whose name is not printed on the ballot, write the candidate's name and address on the line provided and completely fill in the OVAL.
 F. If a majority of the votes cast on a recall question is in the affirmative, then the candidate receiving the highest number of votes for that office shall be elected.
 G. If a majority of the votes on a recall question is negative, the votes cast for candidates shall not be counted, and the incumbent shall not be recalled.
