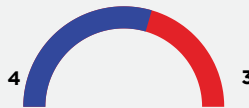

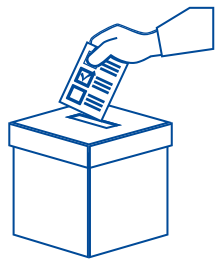

## Filing Deadline



- Major party candidate deadline
  - March 15, 2022 (primary)
- Minor party candidate deadline
  - April 4, 2022 (primary)
- Write-in filing deadline
  - July 21, 2022 (general)

## General Election Rules



### Uncontested Elections

- Uncontested elections are not canceled

### Write In

- Write-in candidates must file by July 21, 2022 with the Secretary of State

### Replacement Candidates

- Replacement candidates allowed

### Winning

- Plurality
- No general runoff

## Primary Election Rules



### Uncontested Elections

- Uncontested primaries are not cancelled, except in a rare circumstance.

### Recognized Political Parties

- American Constitution, Approval Voting, Democratic, Green, Libertarian, Republican, and Unity

### Write In

- Write-in candidates need to file by April 22, 2022 with the Secretary of State

### Winning

- Majority required
- No outright win
- Yes primary runoffs

## Local Rules



- Colorado Springs
  - General runoff elections are possible for the office of mayor. If no candidate receives a majority of the vote in the general election, a runoff election is scheduled for the third Tuesday in May following the general municipal election.
- Adams County and El Paso County elect a surveyor, but Arapahoe County does not, per email communication with the latter county.
