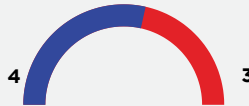

## General Election Rules

### Uncontested Elections

- Uncontested elections are not canceled

### Write In

- Write-in candidates do not need to file

### Replacement Candidates

- Replacement candidates are allowed Nomination of nominee when vacancy in nomination occurs between primary election and general election; procedure for withdrawal based upon legitimate nonpolitical reason

### Winning

- Majority
- Yes general runoff

## Primary Election Rules

### Uncontested Elections

- Uncontested primaries could be canceled, but if not, candidates can receive votes in primary when unopposed.

### Recognized Political Parties

- Democratic
- Green
- Libertarian
- Republican
- Solidarity

### Winning

- Majority required
- No outright win
- Yes primary runoffs

### Write In

- Write-in candidates do not need to file

- One school board in Mississippi is holding regular elections in 2022 for two seats (DeSoto County School District).
  - There are nonpartisan general and general runoff elections
