Nancy confirmed that PBSO is a potential recipient of a \$450,000 gang violence prevention earmark that is in the House Justice Appropriations bill (again, the process still requires full House approval, Concurrence by the Senate and bill approval by the President, all of which is months away). This is very good news in light of a higher rigor that must be met in obtaining specialized funding. We will be preparing letters of thanks to our delegation, particularly Reps. Tim Mahoney and Rob Wexler, whose names are associated with this program, as the process continues on. Thanks, too, to Nancy and her team at Alcalde and Fay for their diligence in pursuit of this issue that's critical to all of Palm Beach County.

The remainder of her report is a capsule of ed-related activities in recent weeks and includes the just-approved HHS Appropriations increase for special education (IDEA).
