IV. Records indicating all disbursements, including payments or other membership-related fees, made since Jan. 1, 2005, to any group or association of which the County or any of its employees is or was a member, or to which the County otherwise remitted funds. Those groups are intended to include, but are not limited to, Illinois Municipal League, Illinois City/County Management Association, Illinois Association of County Board Members, Illinois Association of County Officials, Metro Counties of Illinois, United Counties Council of Illinois, National Association of Counties, If there is a "Kane County Municipal League" or similar organization.

V. Any and all invitations, on paper or in electronic format, all legislative receptions that have been sponsored or otherwise underwritten in whole or in part by the county, along any records indicating the costs incurred for those receptions from January 1, 2005 to January 1, 2009.

If the board has these forms and data in an electronic format, I request that these be provided to me electronically on a CD-ROM or through e-mail in a common editable format (such as .xls or .txt). Please notify me of any fees before completing my request, and please provide an invoice indicating the charges for each document. If your agency does not maintain these records please include the proper custodian's name and address.

As provided by the open records law, I expect your response within five (5) working days. See 5 Ill. Comp. Stat. 140/3(c).

If you choose to deny this request, I request a written **explanation for the denial** including a reference to the specific statutory exemption(s) upon which you rely. I also expect that you release all segregable portions of all otherwise exempt material

PURCHASE ORDER #2007-145

AGREEMENT FOR GOVERNMENT RELATIONS/TRANSPORTATION SERVICES

This Agreement is entered into as of this 13th day of March, 2007 by and between the County of Kane, of 719 South Batavia Avenue, Geneva, Illinois 60134, a body corporate and politic of the State of Illinois (hereinafter referred to as the "County") and Illinois Governmental Consulting Group, L.L.C., of 500 North Dearborn, Suite 1030, Chicago, IL 60610 (hereinafter referred to as the "Consultant").

In consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements contained in this agreement, the County and the Consultant agree, covenant and bind themselves as follows:

1. Services. Consultant agrees to perform for the County the Services as described in Exhibit A, which exhibit is attached hereto, incorporated herein and made a part hereof (hereinafter referred to as the "Services").
2. Direction. The Kane County Engineer or his written designee shall act as the County's sole representative and contact person with the Consultant with respect to the Services to be provided by the Consultant under this Agreement, and may transmit instructions to and receive information from the Consultant with respect to the Consultant Services.
3. Compensation. The County agrees to pay the Consultant for providing the Services set forth herein at a rate of \$3,000 per month plus reasonable expenses incurred by the Consultant in providing the services. Said expenses must be first approved by the County Engineer in writing prior to payment by the County. Said approval by the County Engineer shall not be unreasonably withheld.
4. Sub-consultants. The prior written approval of the County Engineer shall be required before any sub-consultants are hired by the Consultant to complete any part of the Services. Any such sub-consultants shall be hired and supervised by the Consultant and the Consultant shall be solely responsible for any and all work performed by said sub-consultant or sub-consultants in the same manner and with the same liability as if performed by the Consultant.
5. Satisfactory Performance The Consultant's and any sub-consultant's standard of performance under the terms of this Agreement shall be that which is to the satisfaction of the County and meets or exceeds the quality and standards commonly accepted in the industry.
6. Conflict Of Interest. The Consultant covenants that it has no conflicting public or private interest and shall not acquire directly or indirectly any such interest which would conflict in any manner with the performance of Consultant's services under this Agreement.
7. Ownership of Documents The Consultant agrees that all writings, notes, data, reports, drafting, studies, prepared by the Consultant for the County under the terms of this Agreement shall be properly arranged, indexed and delivered to the County within ninety (90) days of written request therefor. The documents and materials made or maintained under this Agreement shall be and will remain the property of the County which shall have the right to use same without restriction or limitation and without compensation to the Consultant other than as provided in this Agreement. All related writings, notes, documents,

information, files etc., created, compiled, prepared and/or obtained by the Consultant on behalf of the County for the Services shall be the property of the County and used solely for the County's Services. The Consultant shall permit the County immediate access to any such document upon the request of the County.

8. Compliance with State and Other Laws. The Consultant and sub-consultants will comply with all State, Federal and Local statutes, ordinances and regulations; and obtain all licenses and permits that are applicable or otherwise required to perform the Services. The Consultant and sub-consultants shall not discriminate against any worker, job applicant, employee or any member of the public, because of race, creed, color, sex, age, handicap, or national origin, or otherwise commit an unfair employment practice.
9. Term. The term of this Agreement shall be from April 1, 2007 through March 31, 2008, unless earlier terminated by either party with a thirty (30) day written notice.
10. Termination. This Agreement may be terminated upon thirty (30) days written notice of either party. In the event of termination, the Consultant shall prepare a final invoice and be due compensation calculated as described in paragraph 3 above for all costs incurred through the date of termination.
11. Payment. Consultant shall invoice the County on a monthly basis for the Services performed and any costs and expenses incurred therefore during the previous thirty (30) day period. The County shall pay Consultant within forty five (45) days of receipt of said invoice.

AGREEMENT FOR GOVERNMENT RELATIONS/TRANSPORTATION SERVICES

This Agreement is entered into as of this 14th day of March, 2006 by and between the County of Kane, a municipal corporation of the State of Illinois (hereinafter referred to as the "County") and Illinois Governmental Consulting Group, L.L.C., 455 North Cityfront Plaza Drive, Suite 1500, Chicago, IL 60611 (hereinafter referred to as the "Consultant").

In consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements contained in this agreement, the County and the Consultant agree, covenant and bind themselves as follows:

1. Services. Consultant agrees to perform for the County the following Services as more fully described in Exhibit A, attached hereto and made a part hereof (hereinafter referred to as the "Services").
2. Direction. The Kane County Engineer or his written designee shall act as the County's representative with respect to the Services to be provided by the Consultant under this Agreement, and shall transmit instructions and receive information with respect to the Consultant Services.

In the event of termination, the Consultant shall prepare a final invoice and be due compensation calculated as described in paragraph 3 above for all costs incurred through the date of termination.
