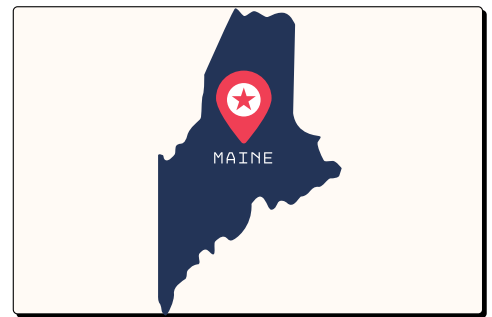

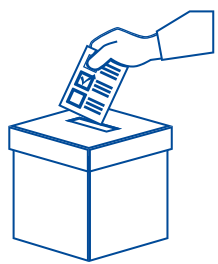

## Filing Deadline



- Primary candidate deadline
  - March 15, 2022
- Primary write-in candidate
  - April 15, 2022
- General candidate deadline
  - June 1, 2022
- General write-in candidate
  - September 9, 2022

## General Election Rules



### Uncontested Elections

- Uncontested elections are not canceled.

### Write In

- Write-in candidates are allowed and must file by September 9, 2022

### Replacement Candidates

- Replacement candidates must be replaced by the party no later than July 25, 2022

### Winning

- Congress will use RCV, all other state-level races will use plurality.
- No general runoff

## Primary Election Rules



### Uncontested Elections

- Uncontested elections are not canceled—vote totals are reported for unopposed candidates.

### Recognized Political Parties

- Democratic Party
- Green Independent Party
- Libertarian Party
- Republican Party

### Write In

- Write-in candidates are allowed and must file by April 15, 2022

### Winning

- RCV
- No outright win
- No primary runoffs

## Local Rules



- Maine uses Ranked-Choice Voting (RCV).
- Augusta's filing deadline is September 9th, 2022, and the general election will be held on November 8th, 2022. Candidates are elected by plurality.
