

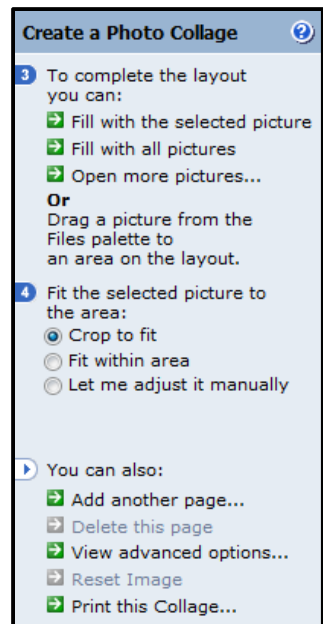
# Photo Collage Project

After experimenting with the Microsoft Digital Image Suite, use your seven best enhanced photos to create a collage similar to the one shown to the right.



## How to create the Photo Collage

1. Import the files you plan to use in your project.
2. Go to the File menu. Select the "Create a Photo Collage" option.
3. Choose the "Album Collage - 7 Photos" layout.
4. Use the "Photo Collage" menu to edit and/or adjust the layout and/or pictures in your collage.



# POSTER COLLAGE CHECKLIST

- ❖ **2 points = Photos:** All seven pictures must be your original creation. In other words, taken by you during class.
- ❖ **7 points = Style:** Each image in the collage must reflect the use of a different effect(s) and/or filter(s). (i.e. black & white, mosaic, charcoal, etc.)
- ❖ **3 points = Title:** Create a unique title for your collage using the text menu. 3 = You're the bomb! 2 = Almost ingenious! 1 = Good try! 😊
- ❖ **1 point = Name:** Use the text menu to place your name on the project.
- ❖ **3 points = Save:** Save your project as both a "Digital Image PNG Plus" file as well as jpg. Place both file types in your Multimedia folder.
- ❖ **1 point = Print:** Print your project. (Use the jpg file to do so.)
- ❖ **10 points = Narrative:** Create a Microsoft Word document to explain the various effects you utilized with each picture included in your collage. Be as accurate and detailed as possible! 😊  
  
Name this file "Photo Collage Narrative" and save it to your Multimedia folder. Print a copy and submit it to me – along with your photo collage. 😊
- ❖ **3 points = Wiki Page:** Create a new page on your wiki entitled "B-A Photo Collage". Generate a title for this page using cooltext.com. Upload your narrative and the jpg version of your collage to this page.
- ❖ **TOTAL POINTS = 30**
