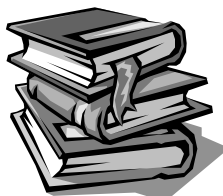

3) **COMPOSITIONS:** There will be a minimum of 3 essays/term.
Presentation requirements:

Clear handwriting or typed.

Use of white DIN-A 4 sheet of paper.

A hand-in deadline will be given, be punctual.

4) **NOTEBOOK.** You are requested to keep a folder or notebook for the English subject. You may be asked to hand it in at the end of every term and it must be neat and up-to-date.

Evaluation:

Your teacher will take into account your **handouts**, whether you've done your **homework** regularly, your **attitude** in class, your **participation** in the activities proposed, as well as your **progress** and **effort** throughout the course.

Every term there'll be **PROGRESS TEST S** that will consist of two parts:

1) **Use of English** (grammar, vocabulary, idioms.).

2) **Skills** (reading, writing and listening). Also, there will be an **Oral Exam** during the second and third term.



The *end-of-term mark* will come out of the following percentages:

Use of English	45% (1 st term)
	30% (2 nd /3 rd term)
Speaking	15% (2 nd & 3 rd term)
Writing essays and skills test	25%
Listening	10%
Reading (including Reader's)	20 %

Also, the following will be taken into account:

Should a student fail to hand in one of the three writing assignments, he or she will have a 0 mark in the corresponding column.

Students with a 15% of absenteeism every term will lose the right to continuous evaluation.

Certificates obtained in other schools or academies won't have any value for the course evaluation.
