#### GRAMMAR:

- VERB TENSES
- CONDITIONAL SENTENCES (*If-*) (*1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> conditional sentences*); *If only / I wish...*
- RELATIVE CLAUSES (Complete sentences with a relative pronoun- join two sentences with a relative pronoun)
- TIME CLAUSES (*When...., As soon as.... After....*)
- REPORTED SPEECH (*She said that..../she asked me if...)( Other reporting verbs: suggested, advised, told me, etc.)*
- PASSIVE VOICE
- MODAL VERBS (must, can, could, should, may, might, etc.)
- CONNECTORS (*However, although, since, consequently, so, etc.*)

#### VOCABULARY:

- Adjective + preposition (to be aware of, to be excited about, to be sad about, to be good at...)
- Verb + preposition: complain about, agree to, consist of, etc.
- Adjectives: personality adjectives (mean, reliable, broad-minded, shy...), physical description (tall, slim, strong), compound adjectives (blue-eyed, long-haired...)
- Phrasal verbs: face up to, carry on, cheat on, get on/get off, look for, look after, put on, put up with, split up with, take care of, think about, try on, turn on, turn off, write down)
- Vocabulary from units: humour, technology, etc.
- Everybody, somebody, myself, themselves, each other...
- Word formation: suffixes and prefixes: impatience, patient, generous, generosity, fair, unfair, etc.
