- A Articulate (good with words), adventurous, affable (relaxed, friendly), awesome (teenage slang: it means "very impressive"!)
- B Bright (clever), bubbly (lively and cheerful, perhaps a bit noisy), boring
- C Cheerful, cosmopolitan, charismatic, chatty (you love talking)
- D Dynamic, dishy (very attractive, but only used for men), down-to-earth (sensible and practical), dull, dodgy (colloquial: not to be trusted)
- E Easygoing, extravagant, easy-on-the-eye (colloquial: attractive), egomaniac (obsessed with yourself)
- F Fit, funloving funky (individualistic in an exciting, modern way), finicky (has to have everything just right)
- G Gorgeous (very attractive), glamorous (like a Hollywood star), genuine (sincere), grungey (teenage slang: fashionable in a rather unwashed, unhealthy way).
- I Intriguing (fascinating)
- J Jolly (happy), jammy (slang: permanently lucky)
- K Kissable
- L Lovable, loopy (eccentric, almost crazy), loony (completely crazy)
- M Modest, more-ish(usually used to describe food that is so good you always want more of it!)
- N Noble,
- O Outgoing (extrovert), open-minded, over-the-top (excessive in your behavior)
- P Positive, pushy (too extrovert, you get what you want by pushing in front of other people)
- Q Quick-witted (clever), quiet
