

# CONDITIONAL SENTENCES

## WORDS OTHER THAN *if*

**UNLESS** = IF NOT

**IN CASE** = THE SITUATION COULD HAPPEN

**PROVIDED THAT / PROVIDING THAT**

**SO / AS LONG AS**

} = on condition that  
(with first conditional)

### 1- Which is the correct word?

1. I'm going to take a cushion to the concert ***in case / unless*** the seats are hard.
2. We'll miss the beginning of the film ***so long as / unless*** you hurry.
3. ***Provided that / In case*** you behave yourself, you can come to the party with us.

5. ***Provided that / if*** I had understood the problem, I'd have done something about it.
