EXAM CONTENT

- Verb + preposition (accuse s/o of, apologise for, believe in, agree with, consist of, etc.) (unit 2)
- Vocabulary: CRIME : people and action verbs; (hacker, stealing, vandalise, arsonist, looting, etc.) (unit 2+ handout)
- Phrasal verbs CRIME: clean up, break into, burn down, clear up, turn into. (handout)
- Adjectives and their opposites (unit 3): moral/immoral, brave/cowardly, guilty/innocent, etc.
- Grammar: conditional sentences: zero, 1st, 2nd, 3rd conditional; if, provided that, providing, unless, in case; wish, if only. (unit 3)
- Vocabulary: SPORT (sponsor, win, lose, beat, referee, supporter, endorse, etc.) (unit 4)
- Phrasal verbs: SPORT (call off, keep up, leave out, give up, catch up, put off)
- Grammar: relative clauses; relative pronouns, defining and non-defining relative clauses, omission of the relative. (unit 4)
