NARRATION: Brooke: So, class, can any of you tell me what a compound word is? McKenzie & Elaina. Oh me, me, pick me! Brooke: Elaina? Elaina: A compound word is a word made up of two different words like FIRETRUCK ^{puke} ! Brooke: Great job, Elaina! That's exactly right.			
		McKenzie & Elaina show an example of making a compound word by linking puzzle pieces together. (2 examples)	
NARRATION: Here's an example! If you have the word 'snow' & you have the word 'ball' you can put them together to make the word 'snowball'!

		FRAME DESCRIPTION McKenzie is teacher Brooke & Elaina are students.	MEDIA LIST AND DESCRIPTION
NARRATION: McKenzie: Today we will be talking about prefixes & suffixes. Can anyone tell me what a prefix or a suffix is? Brooke: I know (knows) A prefix goes at the front of a word & changes the word's meaning. Elaina: And a suffix goes at the end of the word to change the base word's meaning!			
		Brooke & Elaina show an example of a prefix & suffix by linking train cars together. (2 examples of each)	
NARRATION: Here's an example of a prefix! 'Un' can be added to the front of the word 'happy' to mean not happy. An example of a suffix is adding the word 'ful' to 'wonder' to mean full of wonder. wonderful!
