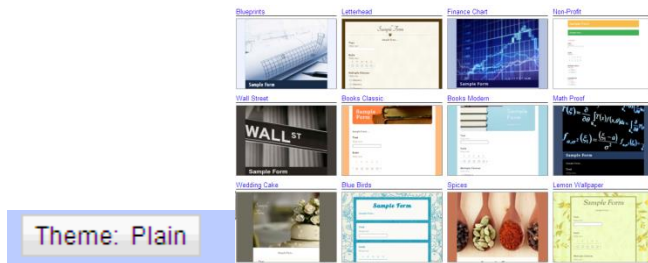
## Google Forms as a form of Assessment and Evaluation
