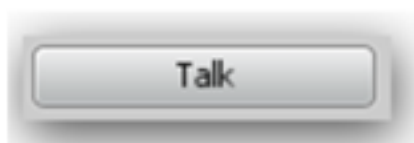


- **Problems?** Check list for audio:

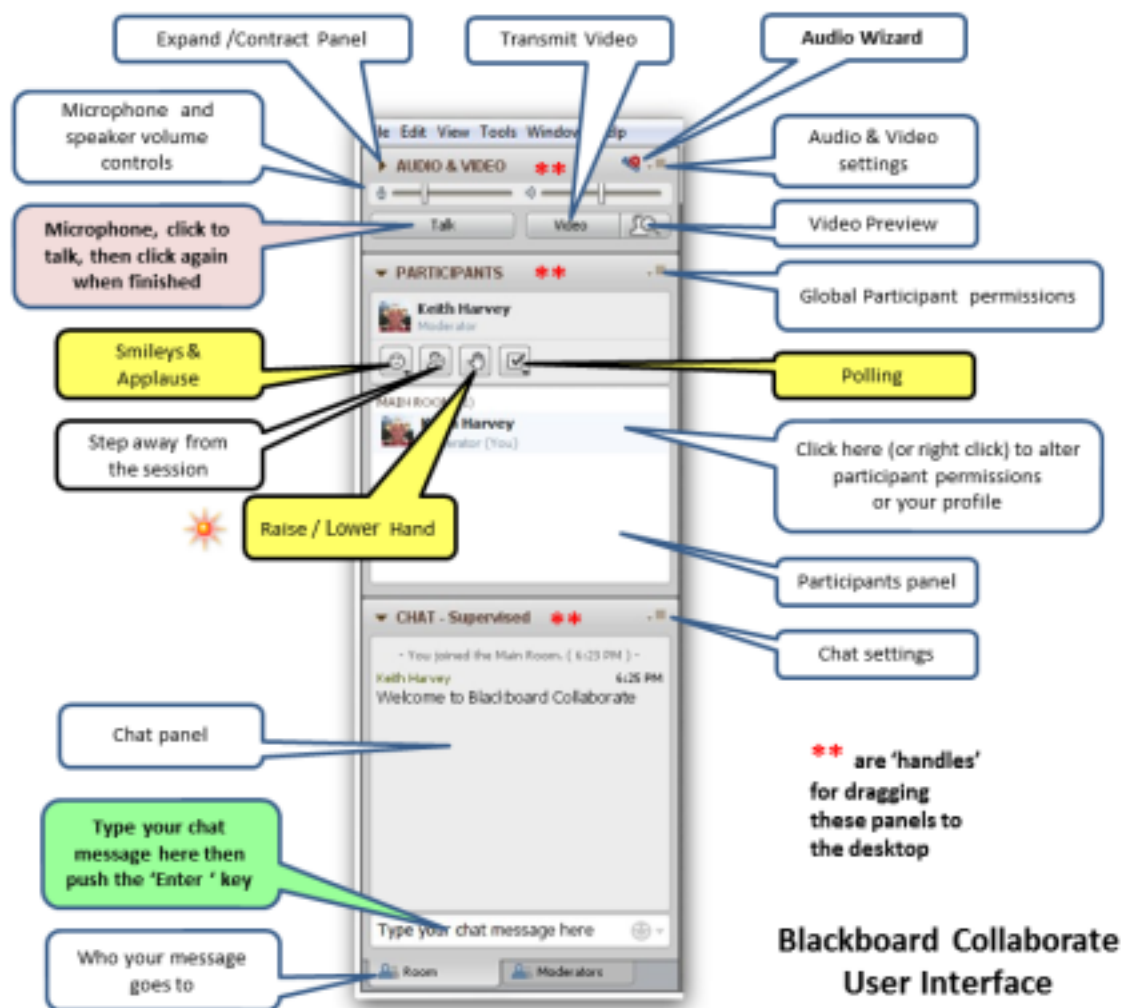

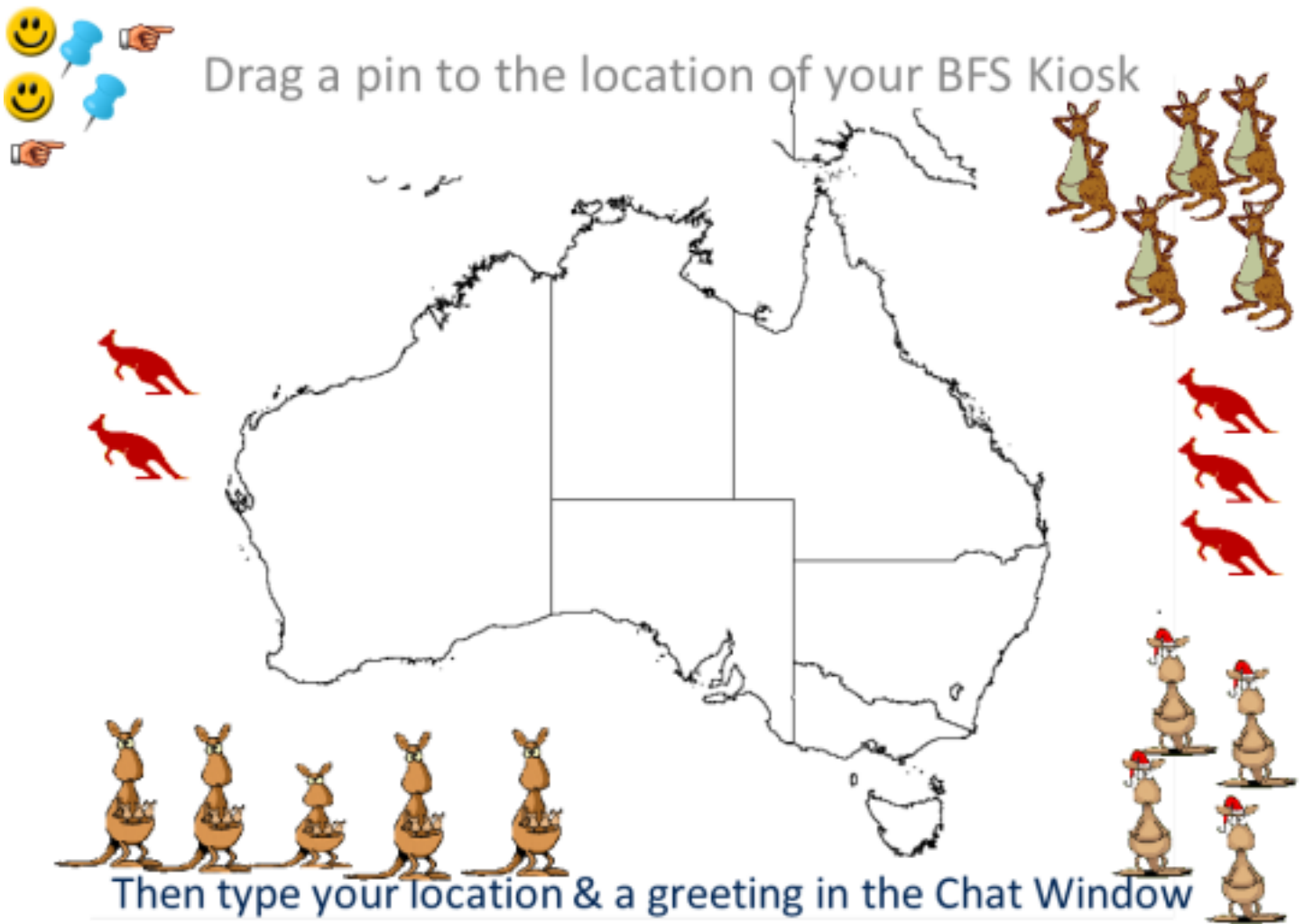

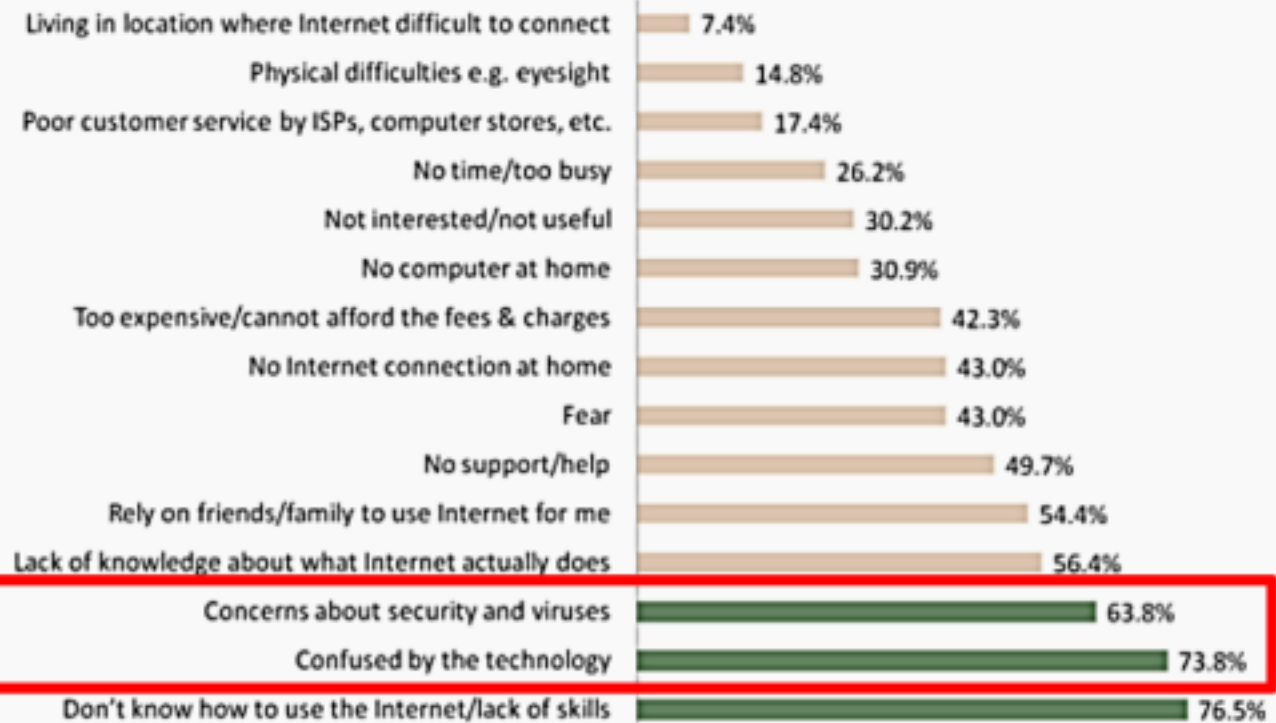

Of Concern:

2009 survey of Australian consumers
by Australian Communications and
Media Authority (ACMA):

- Only 49% of respondents had installed anti - virus software
- Only 21% of respondents had firewalls.

We're in the Wrong Business!

2011 SCAMwatch Report:

- 83,150 contacts. Double 2010
- \$85.6 m reported (\$63.4m, 2010)
- \$: advance fee; winnings; romance.
- Most common loss \$100 - \$499
- Increased high volume scams
- 52% by phone (33%, 2010)

- How do you know who they are?
- NEVER divulge passwords
- Only provide bare minimum info
- Discuss with others
- Stop and Think
- Be Cyber & Scam Savvy

Keith's Basic Precautions

- **ONE** Antivirus program. Free ones OK.
- Firewall On. Windows one is fine.
- Windows fully patched
- Run full virus scan
- Run malwarebytes occasionally
- Link Checker (WOT)
- Have good passwords
- **COMMON SENSE**

- Use a Link Checker
- Know where the link is going to
- NEVER click OK or install those alarming 'you have been infected' popups. Know how to kill off.
- Recognise hoax emails
- Gizmos security wizard

Wi-Fi / Cafes



- Home Wi-Fi
 - Secure your home Wi-Fi access point
 - Set an Admin account password
 - Consider MAC address filtering
- Public access points (internet cafes / others)
 - Avoid financial transactions
 - Make sure to log out of everything
 - Untick 'Remember Me'; Don't save passwords
 - Ensure https: for sensitive info
