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How could we use screen captures?

screen capture of a person trying to follow your instructions - testing them!
To show seniors how to do something they are struggling with

recording your presentation for future students

be great for instructions over the phone can be long and tedious

you could actually record your remote desktop session and deliver it back

Assessment collection

stream an ipad to your pc and capture it from there!

You can do a video demo and have a matching printed sheet

Sharing problems with trainer and clients

you could use screen capture to record a Google Hangout session



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Some ideas

- How to do something – search for items information online
- How to proceed with programs and tools eg powerpoint
- Exploring web pages – locate relevant items
- Narration on visual story – photos, maps, Google Earth
- Instructions for process
- Foster interest
- Help screens for problem-solving
