

YouTube Quick Capture Tutorial

An interactive way to enhance an online course is to provide video instruction. If you have a webcam you can quickly upload short videos, no longer than 10 minutes, to YouTube and link to them in your course. Providing diverse instructional presentations to an online course engages students with creativity. If you do not have a webcam you will not be able to perform this action.

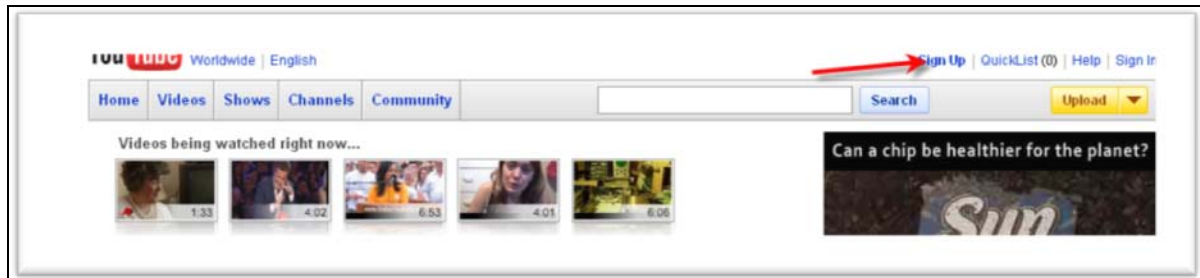
How to Begin?

Begin by accessing [YouTube](https://www.youtube.com).

If you do not already have a YouTube account you will need to create one.

Note: If you have a Google (or Gmail) account already created you can use that to sign in.

Click on **Sign Up** in the upper right hand corner of the initial page.



Next you will have to create your YouTube user account information.

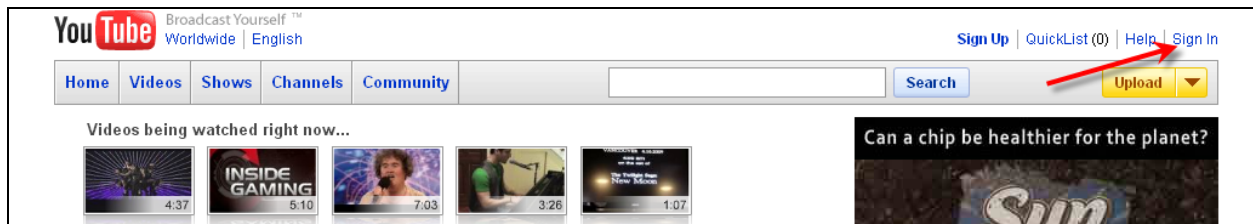

- A. Enter the email address you want other users to be able to contact you with.
- B and C. Enter your password and re-type it for security reasons. You need to keep and store your password in a location that will be easy for your to retrieve.
- D. Your User name will be what appears to other users who view your videos and the name of your channel where your videos will be stored.
- E, F, G, H. Enter your location (country), postal code, date of birth, and gender.
- I. Type the letters in the box into the **Word Verification** space provided.
- J. If you check this box users that know your email address, that you register your account with, will be able to find your channel on YouTube.
- K. Read the **Terms of Use** and **Privacy Policy**. Check the box when you have.

Create my account

When you are finished filling in the required information click

After you have created your account an email will be sent to your registered email to confirm your registration. Click on the link provided to begin your account.



Enter your **Username** and **Password** and click **Sign in**.

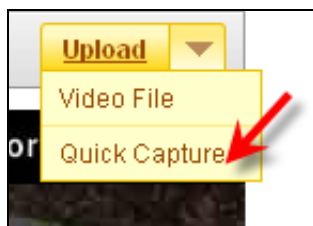
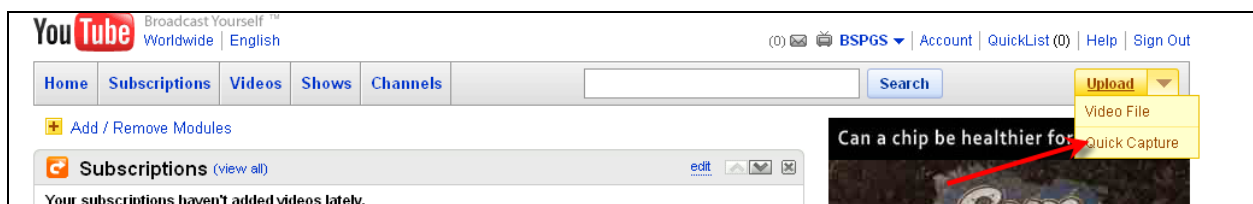

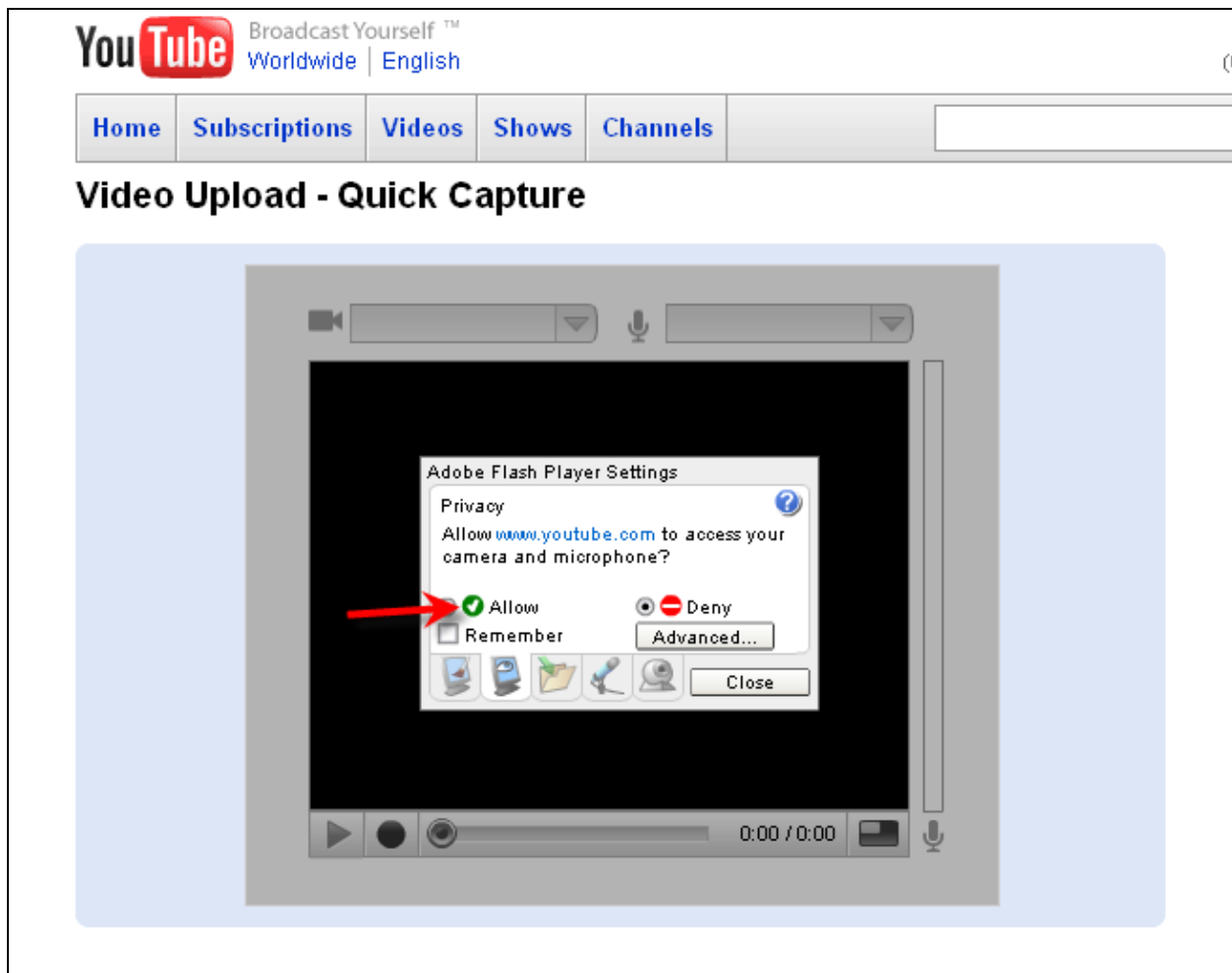
When the screen refreshes you will notice that your Username will appear in the top.



To use **Quick Capture** click the drop down box under **Upload** and click on **Quick Capture**.

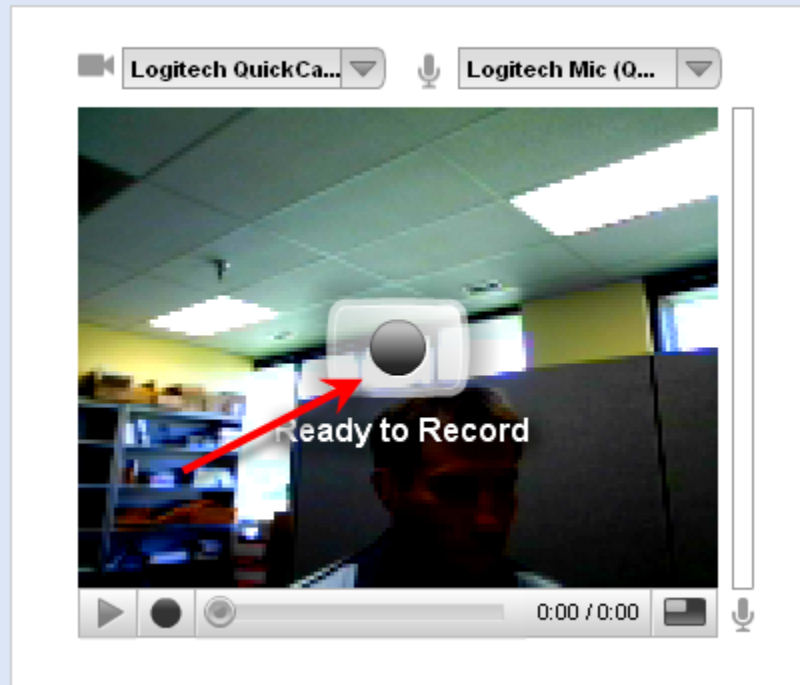


Next you will need to allow YouTube to access your webcam.

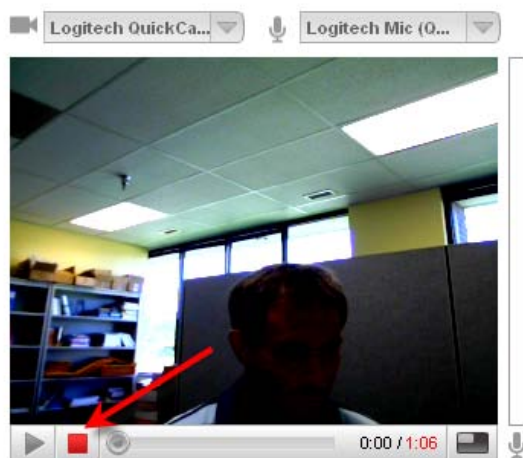


Your next screen will give you the option to begin recording, and when you are ready click on **Ready to Record**.

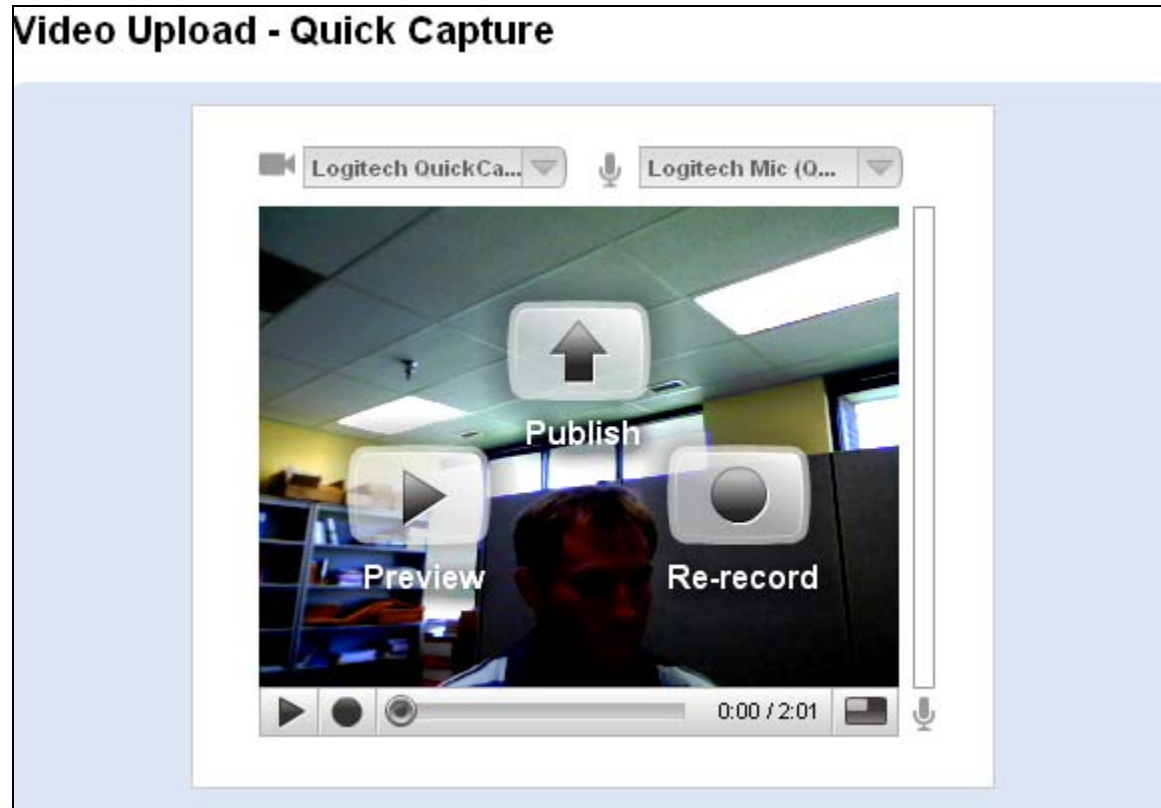
Video Upload - Quick Capture



When you are finished recording your video click the stop button, remember YouTube's maximum amount of time is 10 minutes,



You will be given three options: **Publish** will directly upload the video to your user account; **Preview** will allow you to view it before you upload it; and **Re-record** will allow you to start over.



Once you've determined that you are ready to publish the video, click on **Publish**.

Once you publish the video a screen with a green checkmark will appear and then the page will refresh. In this next screen there are some setting features that need pointing out.

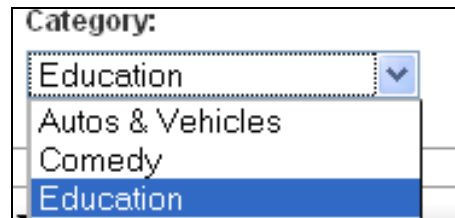

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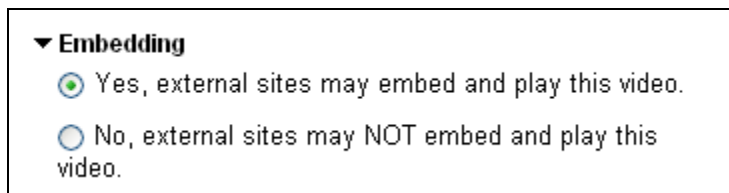

The setting functions covered here are only the basic ones needed; try out different features to understand which work best for you.

- A. Provide your video with a clear title that you will be able to identify with in the future.
- B. The words you enter here will be the same words that make the video searchable for YouTube users.



- C. Use the drop down menu and select **Education**.
- D. For you to be able to embed or link to the video you will need to **Share your video with the world**.
- E. Click on **Embedding** and choose **Yes, external sites may embed and play this video**. That will allow you to link or embed your video.



- F. You need to click on **Save Changes** for the video to be accessible.

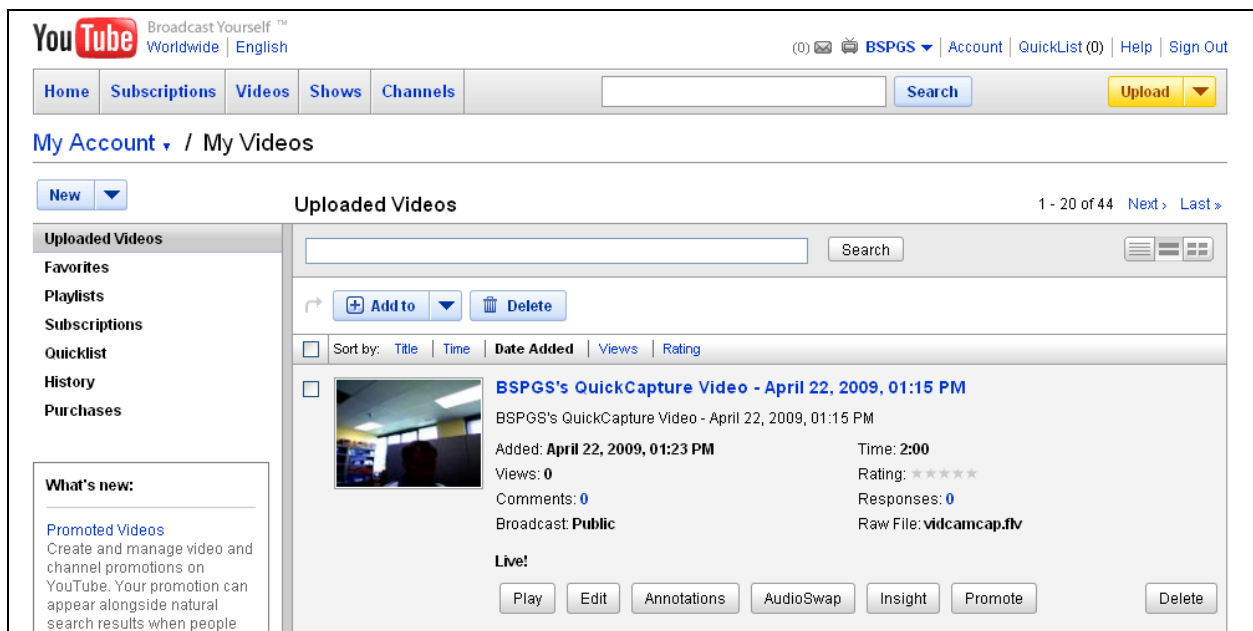


Access Your Video

Once you have determined the settings you can access your video by clicking the drop down menu next to your user name and clicking on **My Videos**.



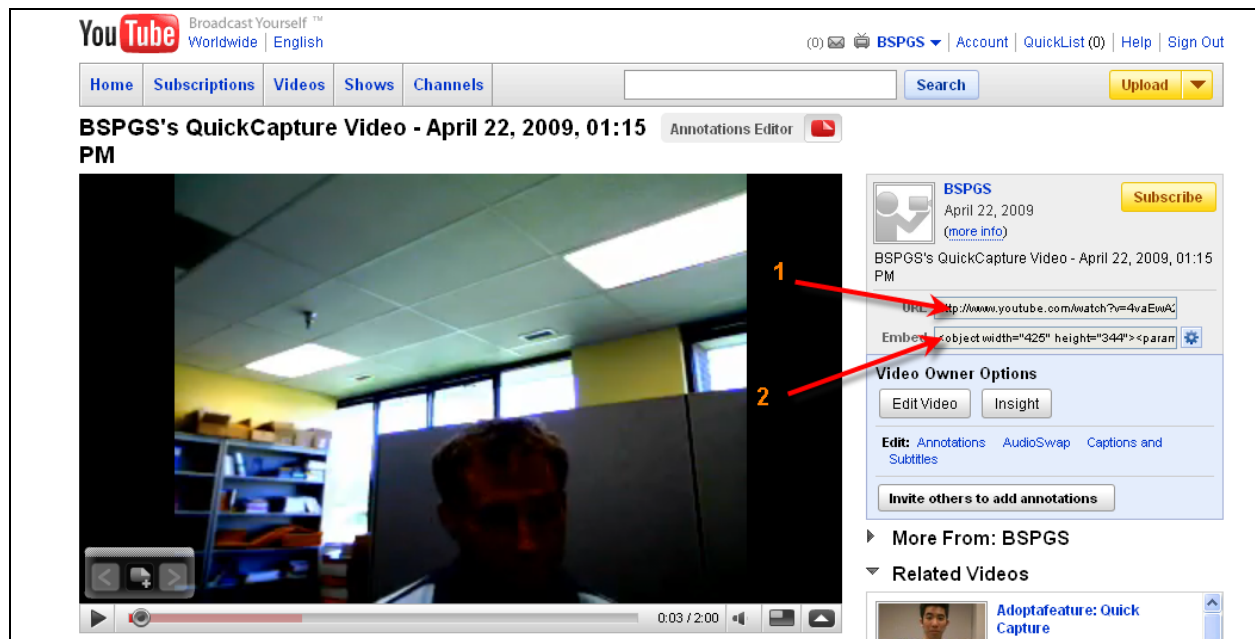
The next screen will show you a still image of your video and information about the video.



Click on **Play** to view the video and retrieve the link or embed code.



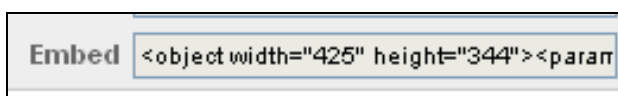
When the screen refreshes your video will appear in YouTube.



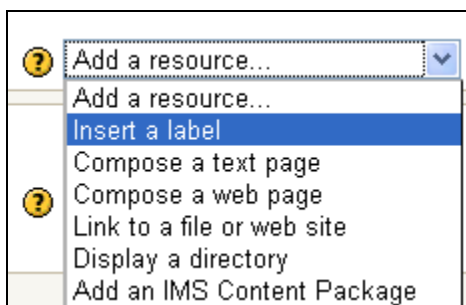
1. This is the URL link. Using this link will take users in your course to this video in YouTube.
2. This is the code to embed your video. Embedding a video means your students would not link out to YouTube but view the video in Moodle.

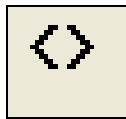
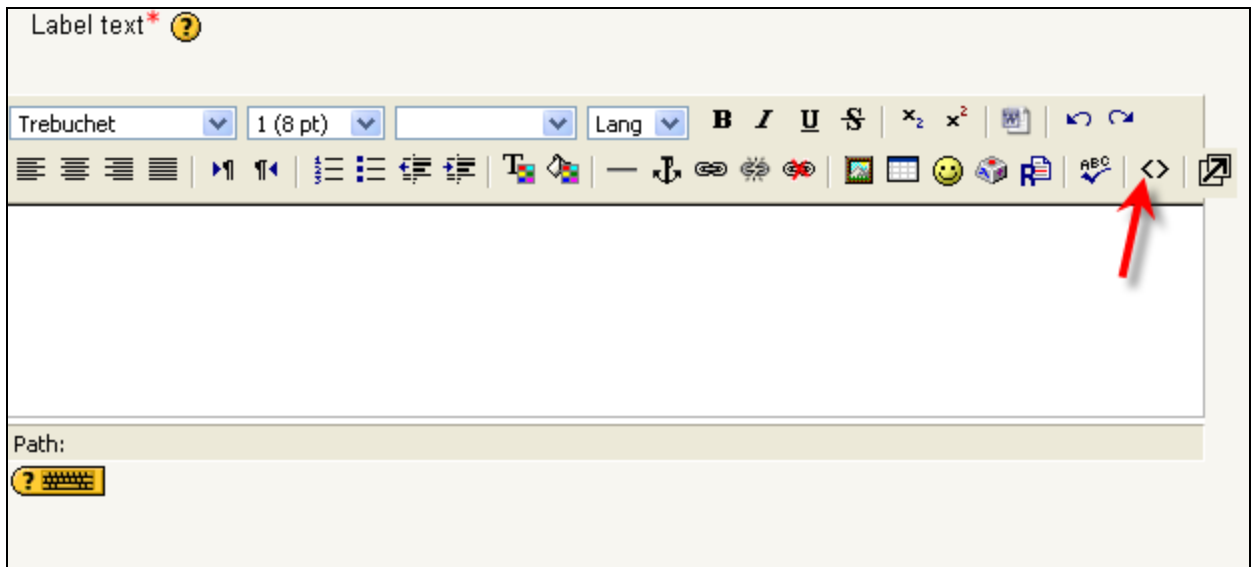
Embedding the Video


To embed the video into Moodle copy the Embed code from YouTube.

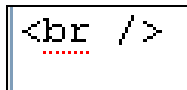



Then access your Moodle course and under **Add a resource...** choose **Insert a label**.

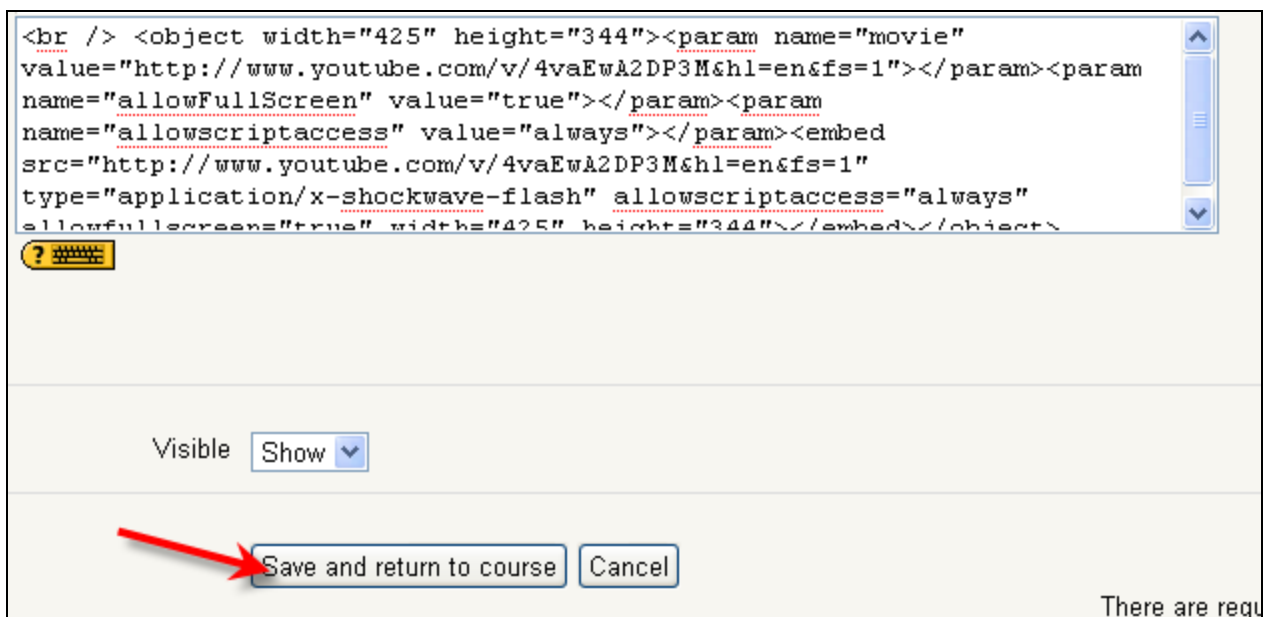




After the screen refreshes click on  in the tool bar at the top. This will switch the text box to house html code.

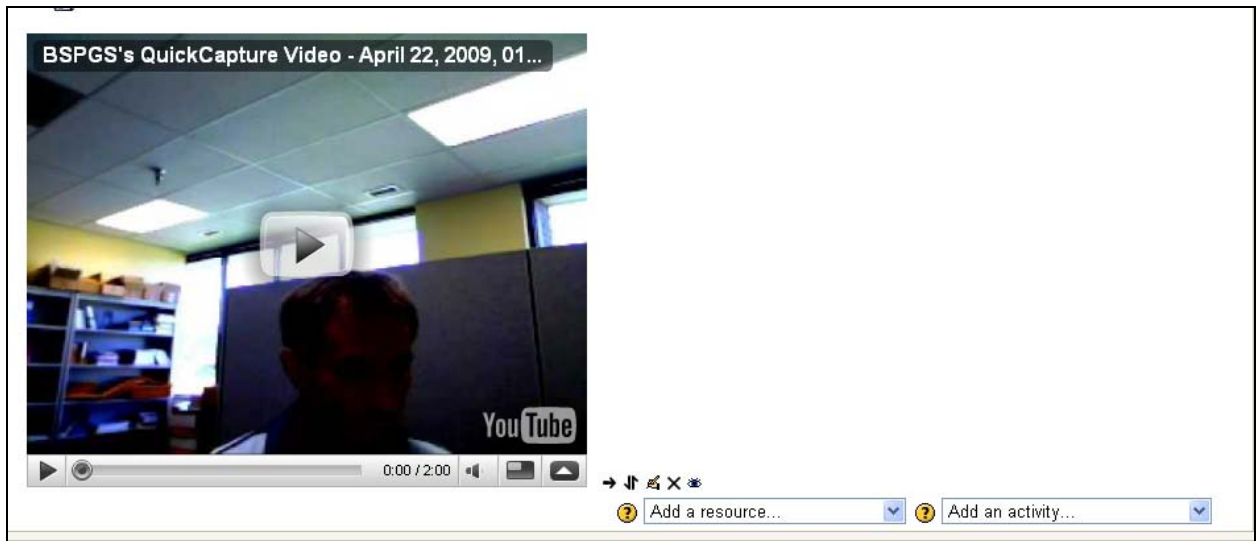


Behind the  past in the embed code from YouTube.



The click on **Save and return to course**.

Your video will then appear and play in Moodle on the interface for your students.



Instructing online can offer anonymity, but utilizing free features such as these can add a layer to instructional methodology while maintaining interest of students. Sometimes tone, body language, and a visual image resonate better with a student. This feature makes that option possible.
