Screenr is a Web 2.0 tool that allows users to capture a computer screen's images and movements with an audio track.

What do you need for Screenr?

- A webcam/microphone to be able to record audio
- Java installed on your computer
- A Twitter account OR
- A YouTube Account

Sign in to Screenr using your Twitter account information. Publish videos through Screenr or uploading them to YouTube. The information below illustrates how to install Java (which Screenr requires to operate), create a Twitter account, create a YouTube account and use Screenr.

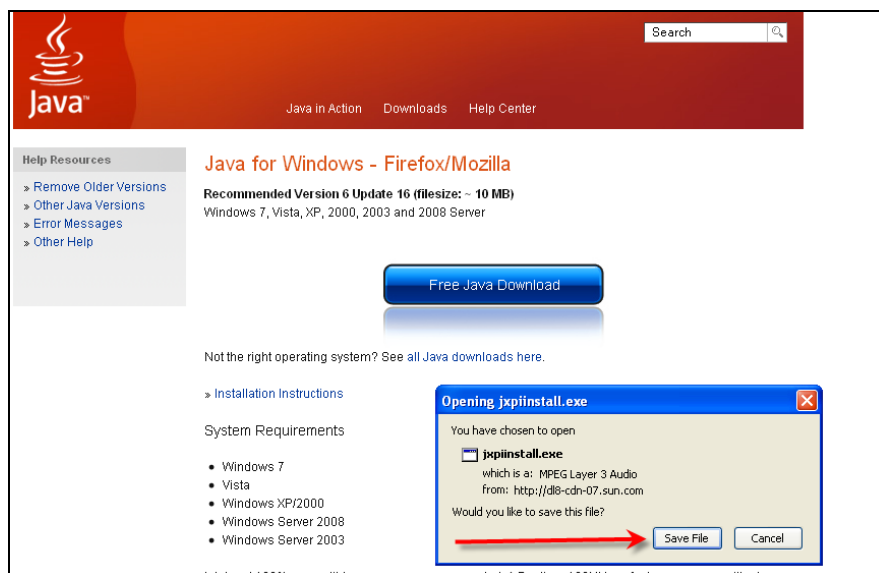
Installing Java

Java must be installed on your computer for Screenr to function properly.

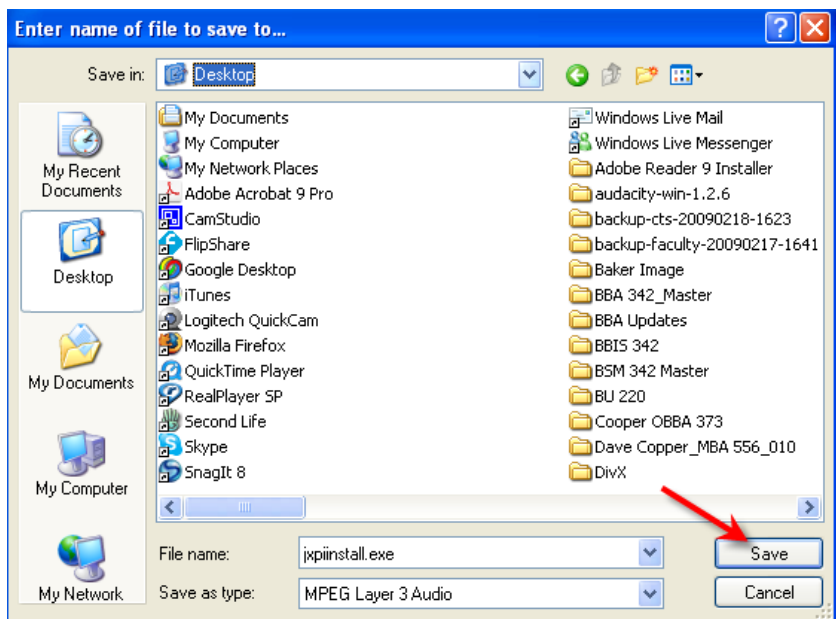
Go to [Java's](http://java.com) website and click **Free Java Download**.



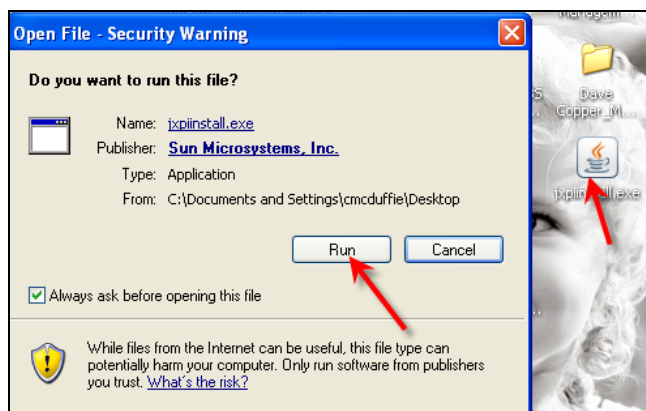
Click **Save File**.



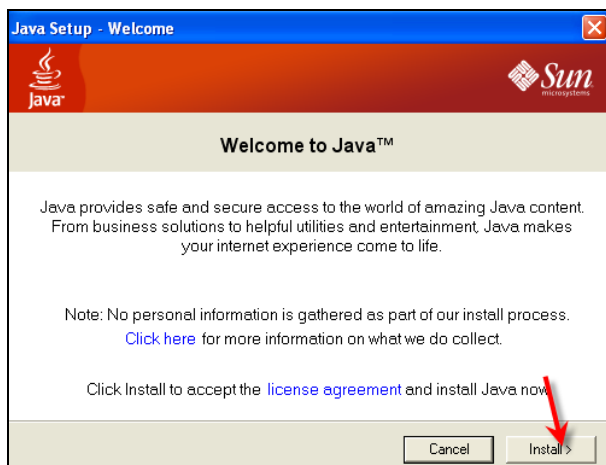
Choose where on your computer you want to save the file. The click **Save**.



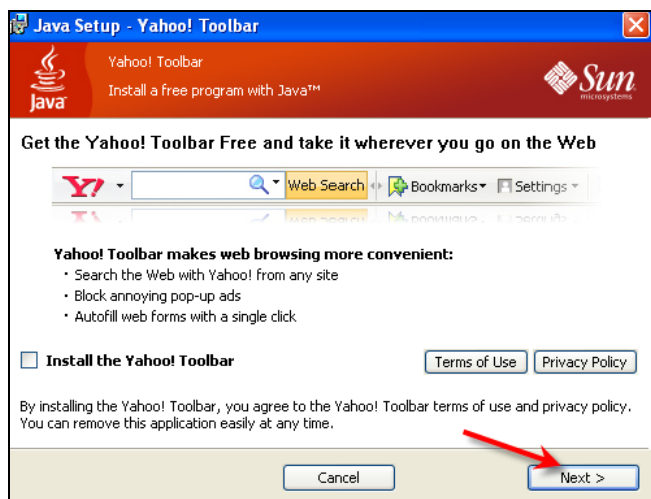
Next, go to where you saved the file, and double click the icon, and choose **Run**.



Choose **Install** after you read the license agreement.



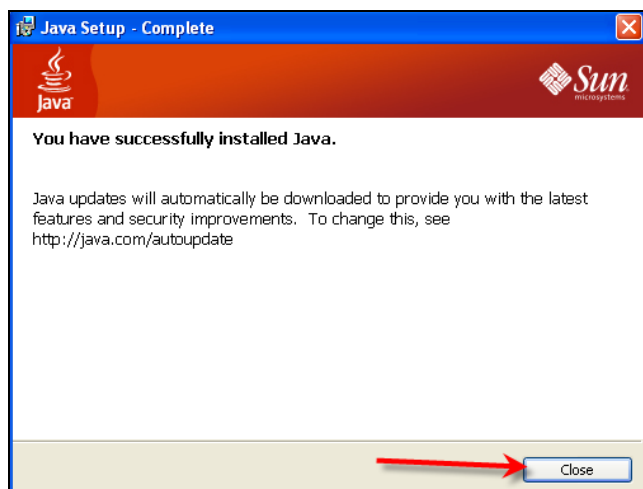
Choose whether or not you want the Yahoo! toolbar installed on your web browser and then choose **Next**.



Java will next show you a screen of the installation progress.



When the installation is finished click **Close**.

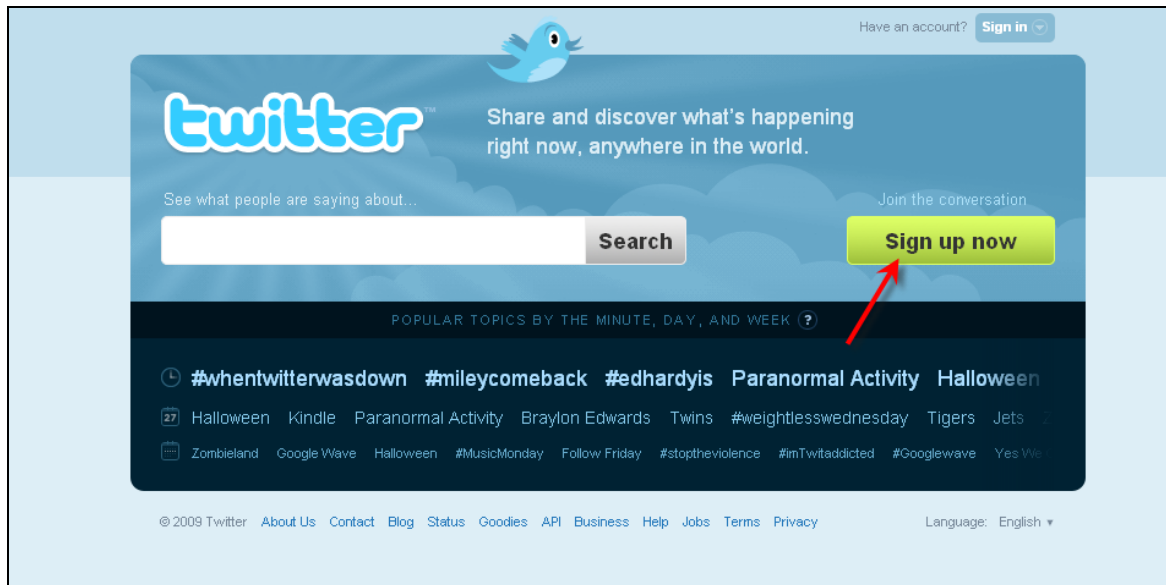


Setting Up Your Twitter Account

Sign Up

Create a twitter account by going to <http://twitter.com/>.

Click **Sign up now**.



When the screen refreshes, enter information to create your account.



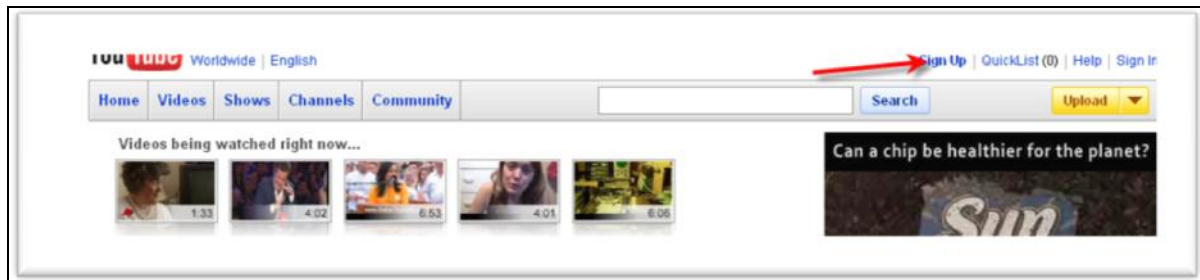
Twitter will then give you more options to design your account's appearance. For the purpose of Screen all you need is to have the account set up.

Create Your YouTube Account

Create a YouTube account (if you do not already have one.) Screenr has the option to publish and link to your screencast through YouTube. YouTube offers more storage space than Screenr.

Note: If you have a Google (or Gmail) account already created you can use that to sign in to YouTube.

Click **Sign Up** in the upper right hand corner of the initial page.

Create my account

- A. Enter the email address where other users can contact you.
- B and C. Enter your password and re-type it for security reasons. You need to keep and store your password in a location that will be easy for you to retrieve.
- D. Your User name will be what appears to other users who view your videos and the name of your channel where your videos will be stored.
- E, F, G, H. Enter your location (country), postal code, date of birth, and gender.
- I. Type the letters in the box into the **Word Verification** space provided.
- J. If you check this box, users that know your email address, the one you registered your account with, will be able to find your channel on YouTube.
- K. Read the **Terms of Use** and **Privacy Policy**. Check the box.

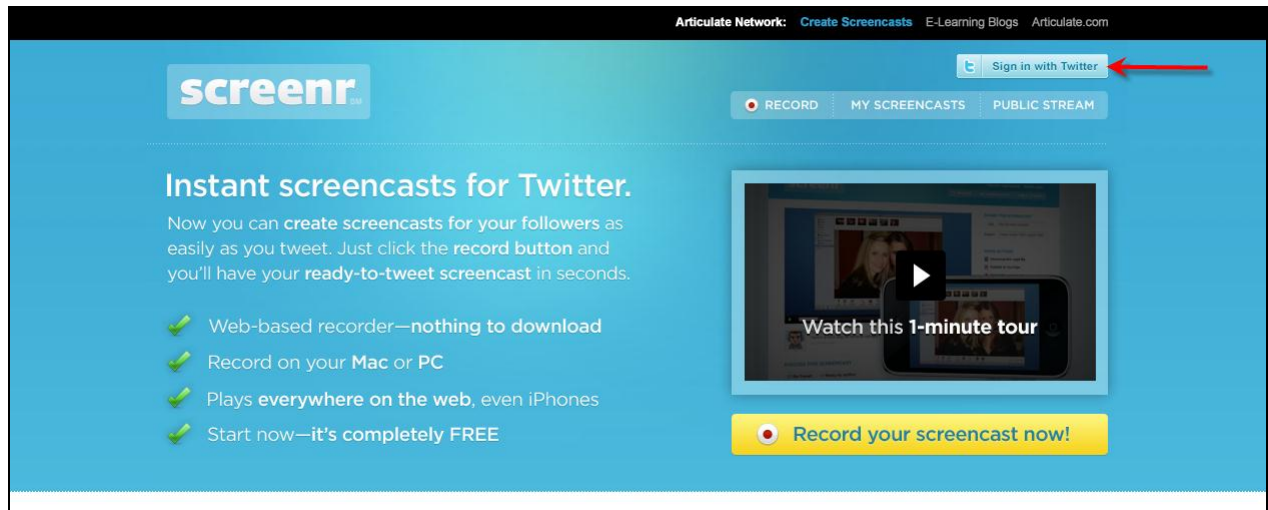

Using Screenr

Go to <http://screenr.com/>

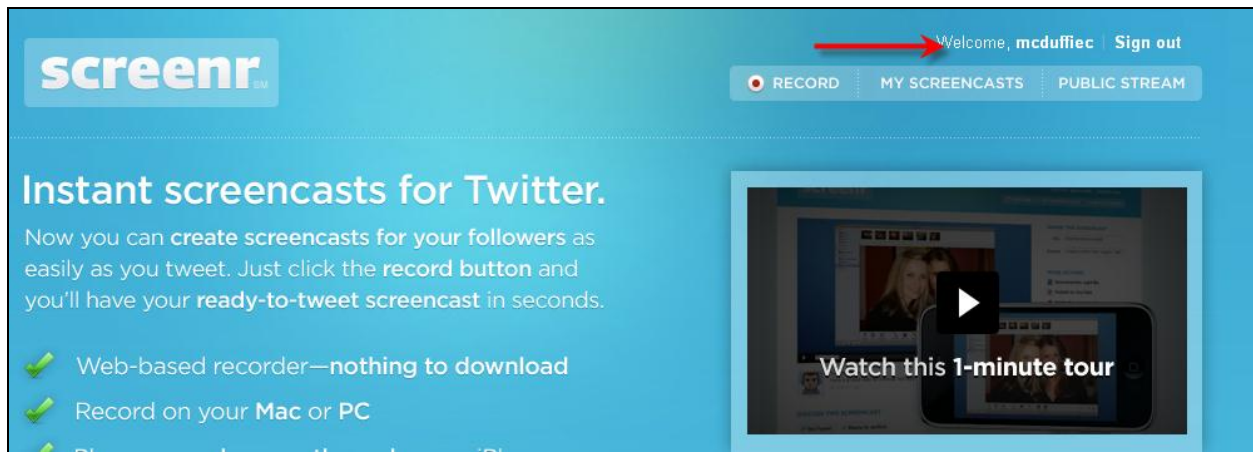
Click **Sign in with Twitter** in the upper right corner.



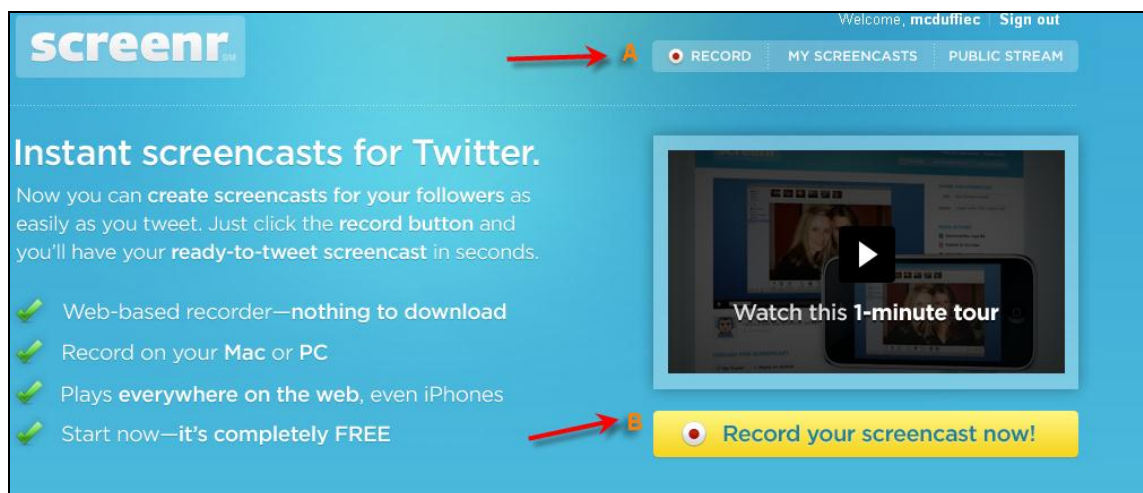
Enter your twitter **Username** and **Password** and choose **Allow**.



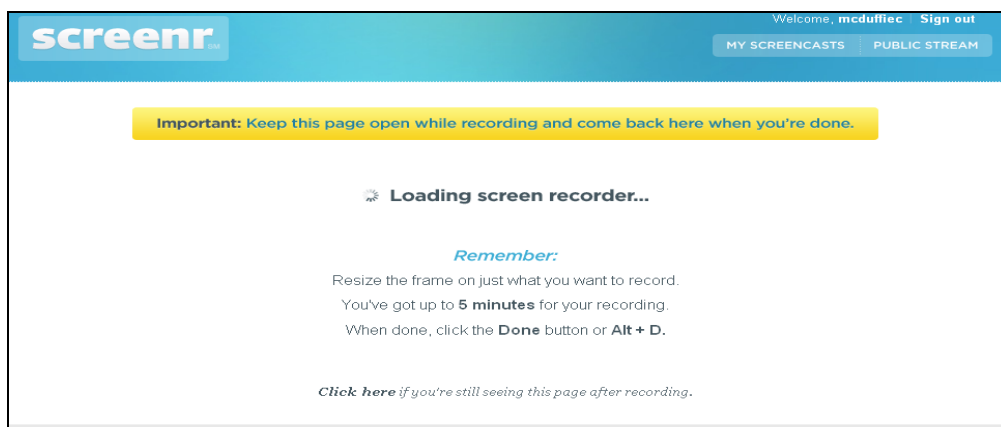
You will be redirected back to Screenr and your username will appear in the top right.



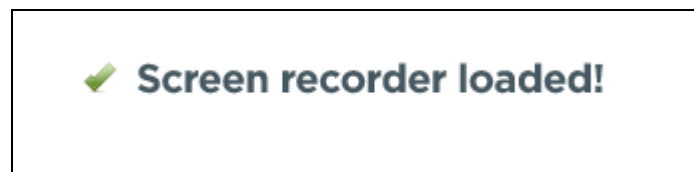
To begin to recording your screencast you can click either A or B:



Screenr will next check to ensure Java is installed and load the recorder (you do not have to download anything to your computer).

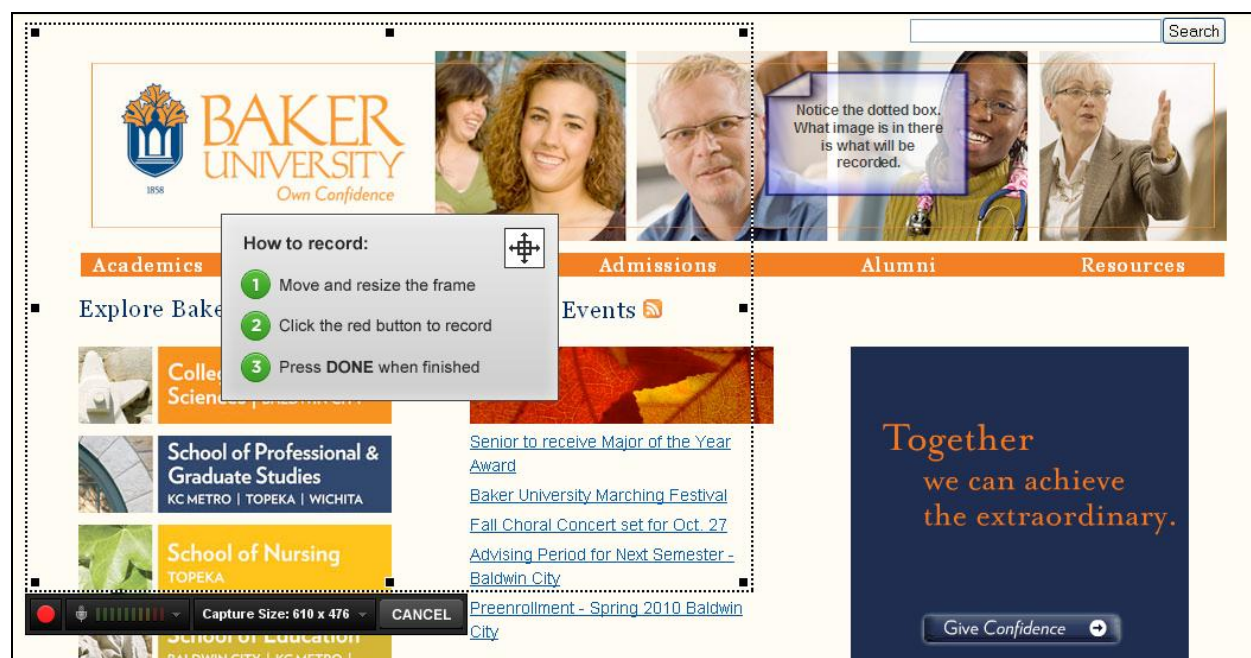


Once it is loaded you will see:








After it is loaded you will see a dotted outlined box with functions just below it.

The section of the screen that appears within the dotted box will be recorded.



The tool bar at the bottom lets you:

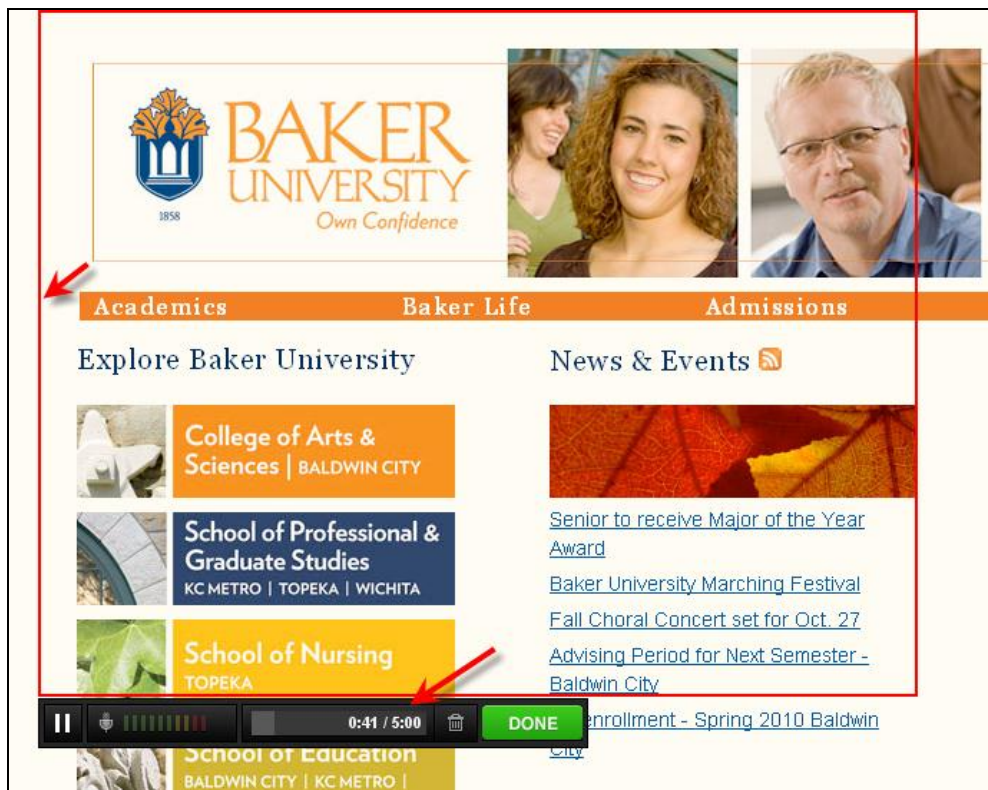
- Begin recording by clicking  (Note: Screenr will automatically pick up the microphone installed in your computer.)
- See the volume recorded from your microphone 
- Know the size you are capturing (Note: for YouTube 610 x 410 works very well).

- You can cancel the recording at any time by clicking 

You can drag the dotted box and move it to different parts of the screen by holding your cursor over the dotted line until you see this image . Once you see this image left click your mouse and hold it down to drag the dotted box.

Once you press  Screenr will count down from 3 to 0 to help you prepare to record.



You will know screenr is recording because the dotted line will change to solid red and the time will count up from 0:00 (**Note**: You can only record 5 minute video clips.).



Change screens and images as often as you like during the recording.

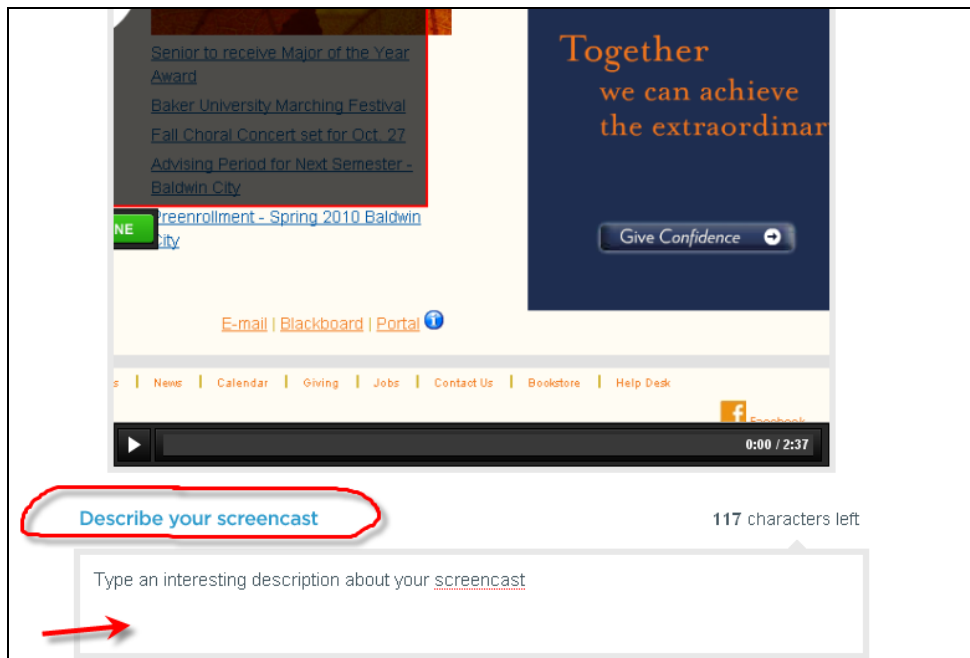
When you are finished recording click

DONE

Go back to Screenr's home page, where your screencast will appear.



Type a note about your recording in the **Describe your screencast** box. The screencast will initially be sent as a tweet with the message you type here appearing with it.



Once you've typed in your message choose to **Tweet It!** .

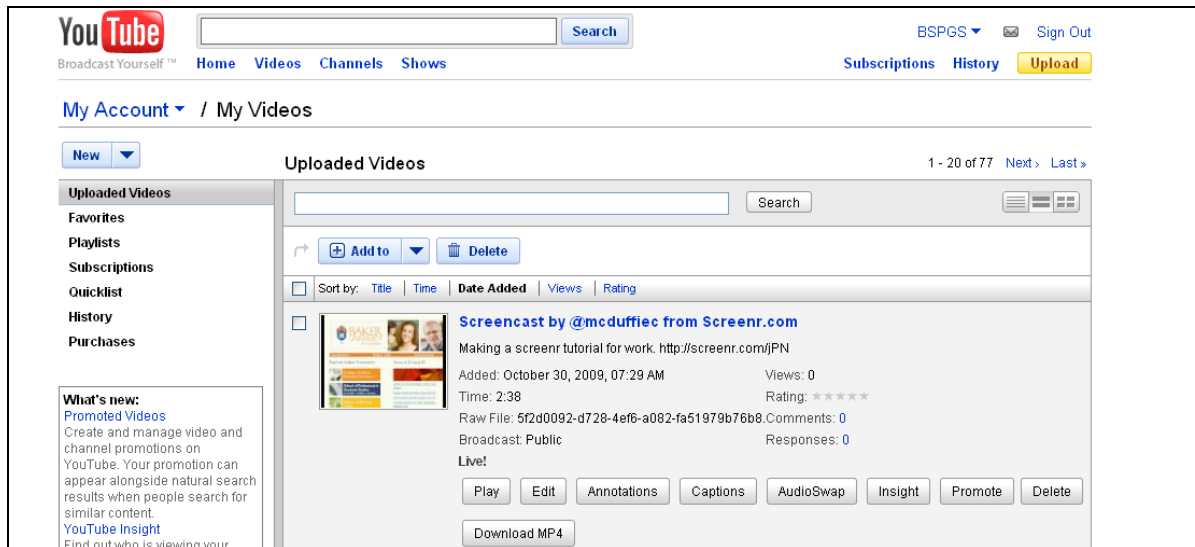
Once it is finished you can click **Go to YouTube** to view your video.



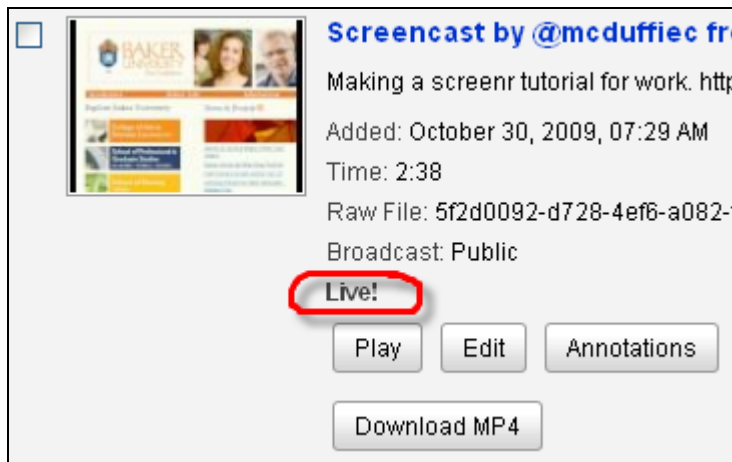
You will then be directed to sign in to YouTube using your YouTube **Username** and **Password**.




Once you sign in you will be taken directly to **My Videos within YouTube** where you can view your video.
