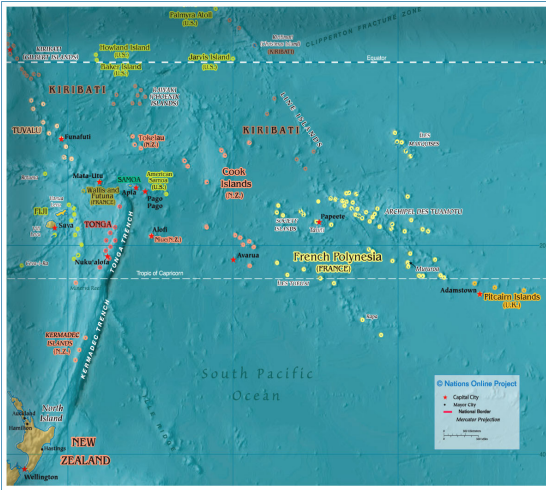


MAP

You Should Move Here!

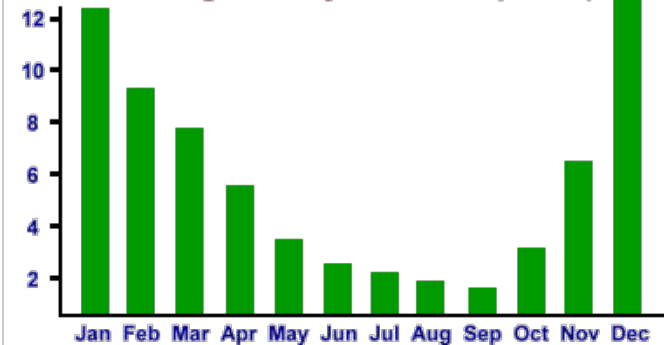

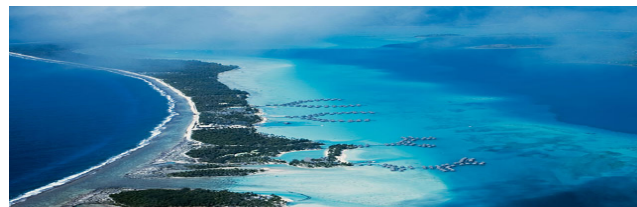
This is some of the trees that are in Polynesia



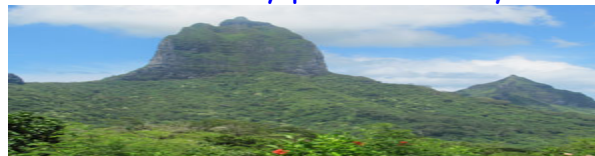
This is a tropical island.
