TOPIC SENTENCE

BODY

Supporting Sentence 1

Supporting Sentence 2

In this sentence, give another specific detail relating to the main idea of the paragraph.

Supporting Sentence 3

In this sentence, give another specific detail relating to the main idea of the paragraph.

CONCLUDING SENTENCE

The concluding sentence refers to the topic sentence and sums up the main idea of the paragraph.

The fourth part of the paragraph is where the writer is getting to the end of their essay and is trying to sum up the main part of their writing. This paragraph should contain your weakest argument or point.
