

TOK Essay Outline, Question: ‘The possession of knowledge carries an ethical responsibility.’ Evaluate this claim.

I. Introduction

A. Main thesis:

1. Those who possess knowledge are capable of leadership, leadership can essentially influence an individual's or society's moral and ethical values.
