4. a broad flat region extending from the Arctic Ocean into the U.S. located west of the Canadian shield
7. the boundary that separates rivers flowing towards opposite sides of a continent
8. a political division of land in Canada, similar to a state in the United States
9. a huge, slow moving mass of snow and ice
10. an island of Canada that is off the east coast
12. a deep narrow inlet of the sea between steep cliffs
13. a river or stream that flows into a larger river
14. deposited by water, relating to the fertile topsoil left by rivers after a flood
18. a part of a river with swiftly flowing water
