

Lesson Plan – David Lewis – 6th Grade Geography**Week of:** 2/02/2015 – 2/06/2015**Purpose:** **Blue** and **Red**: Students will learn about the countries of North America, view the website projects, and evaluate their own and peers' group work**Green**: Students will learn about the U.S. States and Canadian Provinces, create websites about their chosen states, view the website projects, and evaluate their own and peers' group work**Daily Routine:** During the first 10-15 minutes of class, students complete a JumpStart activity that reviews previous learning or introduces new topics or concepts.
