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Formatting Your Works Cited Page

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 - **Book with multiple authors:** Name the authors in the order in which they are listed in the source. List last name first for only the first author
 Gillespie, Paula and Neal Lerner. *The Guide to Peer Tutoring*. Boston: Allyn, 2000. Print
 - **Work from an anthology or collection:** Begin with the author and title (in quotes) of the selection, then give the title (italicized) and editor of the collection (preceded by *Ed.* Meaning edited by)
 Trilling, Diana. "The Image of Women in Contemporary Literature." *The Woman in America*. Ed. Robert Jay Lifton. Boston: Houghton, 1965. 42-50. Print
 - **Essay from an online database:** Author's last name, Author's first name. "Title of Article". Title of Periodical (Journal, Magazine or Newspaper). Volume Number (Date): pages. *Database* (Gale or EBSCO). Web. Date of Access.
