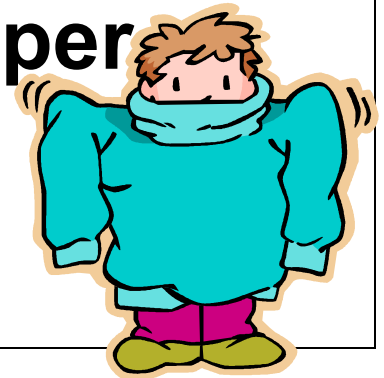
Adjectives are describing words

- They went in to the **deep pool**.



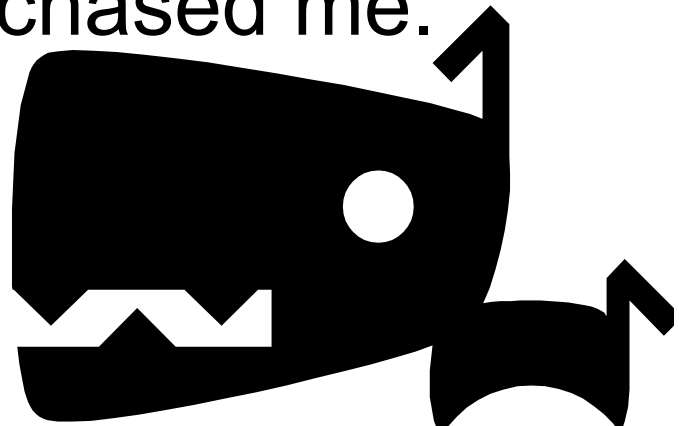
Adjectives are describing words.

- I walked round the **old creepy** house.



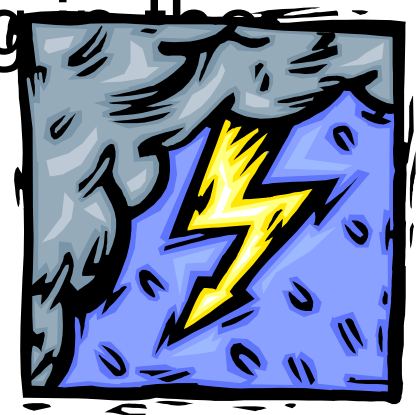
Adjectives are describing words

- Dad walked down the **quiet narrow** street.

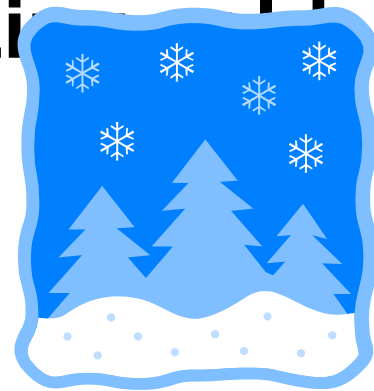


Adjectives are describing words

- I walked through the **freezing** snow.

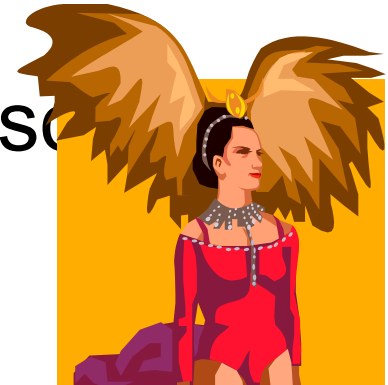


Adjectives are describing words

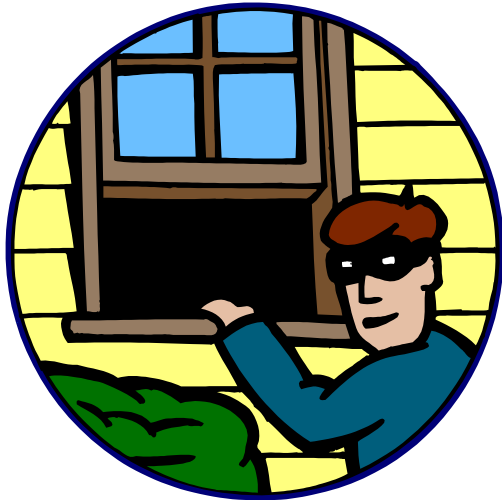
