# Tundra Bioregion

- **Location:** Arctic Canada
- **Plants:** Very short growing season  
shrubs  
wildflowers  
moss  
lichen  
grow in a very short time

# Tundra Bioregion

- **Animals:** Caribou  
Birds  
Seals
- **Climate:** harsh  
long cold winters

# Tundra Bioregion

- **People:** Human habitation is sparse  
Inuit- hunt caribou in summer  
and seals in the winter

# Wetlands Bioregion

- **Location:** The Canadian Shield
- **Plants:** that thrive with wet roots  
water plants- lillies  
rock not far beneath surface  
water will not soak through rocks  
biodiverse- great variety of plants  
and animals

- **Climate:** Warm and Wet
- **Animals:** Moose  
bald eagles  
beaver  
Otter

- **Location:** Great Lake- St. Lawrence Region
- **Plants:** Ontario plant- trillium  
Forest Area- Firewood and  
maple sugar bush
- **Animals:** Deer  
Raccoons
