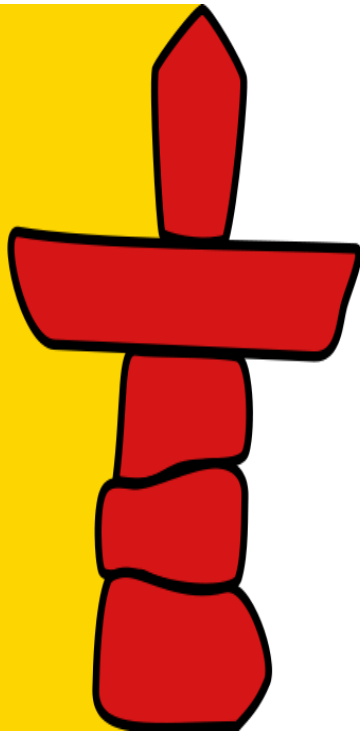

# Nunavut: The Changing of the Times

- Nunavut means “Our Land”
- Population: 34, 152
- Language: Inuktitut (which means “In the manner of the Inuit”)
- Climate: Arctic to Subarctic. Very long and very cold winters. Summers are brief and cool

- Average Temperatures

January: Early Morning -30

July: 11.6

For every 1000 people there are 80 have cars  
(Canada 465)
